

SHREVEPORT, La. (AP)—Centenary honed its attack today for its NCAA small college engagement with East Tennessee State after closing the season with a 92-74 victory over Florida State.

The Gents entertain the Tennessee squad in an open round tournament game Tuesday.

Florida State headed the Gents 36-28 with six minutes left in the first half last night. But Centenary guard Milt Williams hit a hot streak with 10 points and tied the game.

Centenary went in front 46-44 at the start of the second half and led the rest of the way.

The Gents assigned two men to FSU guard Hugh Durham and they held the high-scoring playmaker to 14 points. Durham had averaged 30 points per game in his last seven outings.

Centenary finished the season with a 16-8 record while Florida State, going against Loyola at New Orleans tonight, has a 9-16 mark.
