

Loyola University used an amazing display of shooting accuracy to hand Florida State its seventh basketball defeat here last night, 79-67.

The New Orleans Wolfpack dropped 26 Of 49 tries from the field for a .531 showing and hit 28 straight free throws without a miss.

The loss left FSU with a 3-7 season mark. Loyola now has a 7-3 showing for the campaign.

THE BIG GUNS

Captain-forward, Pete Gaudin was the top sharpshooter for the victors with 26 points, while guard Bob McLaughlin added 22. Guards Hugh Durham and Jim Liteky led the Seminoles in a losing effort with 20 and 19 points respectively.

The Seminoles started fast and gained a 10-4 lead in the first 3½ minutes, with Durham accounting for five of the points.

Once Loyola caught up it was never headed again. Less than five minutes later the Wolfpack led 18-14. From there the Pack pulled steadily away to a 43-35 halftime margin.

goal tries for a .556 showing during the first half, while the Seminoles found the range on just eight of 31 for .258.

In the first five minutes of the final half, Loyola pulled away to a 58-31 margin before the Seminoles cut the margin down.

The Tribe rallied in the final minutes, but the lead was too much to overcome. The 12-point margin Loyola held at the finish was its smallest since the middle of the first half.

The Wolfpack continued its tremendous rebounding by out-rebounding the Seminoles 55-29. Loyola leads the nation in this department.

NO. 1 SCORER

Liteky's 19-point showing enabled him to take over the Seminole scoring leadership with 167 points and a 16.7 average through the first 10 games of the year.

Forward Burt Deckel, who scored just seven last night, is second with 151 and a 15.1 average while Durham is third with 136 and a 15.1 mark for nine games.

Thursday night, the Seminoles go after their fourth triumph again, against the University of Tampa at the FSU gym. Game time will be 8:15.
