

Florida State used a balanced scoring attack and a big rebound advantage to chalk up its second straight basketball victory here last night, defeating Rollins, 80-61.

Four Seminoles hit double figures to more than offset the 23 points of Rollins' freshman guard Dick Bishop, who was the game's leading scorer.

Tribe senior forward Larry Strom had 17, Murt Deckel 15, Hugh Durham 13 and Danny Boltz 10 to pace the Seminoles.

SEVENTH HERE

The win upped the Seminoles' season pace to 8-13, and it was their seventh win in nine appearances on the home court. They have won four of five games played against state teams, losing only a 71-70 thriller to Florida.

Rollins now stands 8-12 for the year.

Coach Bud Kennedy's Seminoles used a zone defense for second straight game, and again it bottled up the opposition's big man, 6-5 center Dick Bezemer.

Bezemer bagged just eight points, thanks partly to another good job by Boltz, who out-rebounded Bezemer, 15-12.

After initial difficulty feeling out the Seminole defense, Rollins gained an early lead and held it until late in the opening half when the Seminoles retorted and gained a 33-27 halftime edge.

BOOST MARGIN

Rollins failed to hit from the field in the first nine minutes of the final half, and the Seminoles shot to a 55-32 margin, after which they were never threatened.

The Tribe outshot the visiting Tars afield, dropping 29 of 81 for a .358 showing, while Rollins bagged 21 of 64 for a .328 mark.

Rollins won the battle at the foul line, but even here the

Seminoles had a superior number good. Rollins dropped 19 of 24 for .792, FSU 22 of 29 for .759.

In an opening encounter, the Florida State freshmen outlasted a stalling South Georgia Junior College, 40-27, for their fourth straight victory and fifth of the season against two defeats.

Bobby Conrad, with 12, and Bill Archer, with 11, led the Baby Seminoles, while Jack Moore dropped 10 for the losers.

Next Tuesday night, the varsity returns to the hardwoods to face rugged Memphis State here. The Tigers beat the Seminoles, 59-56, earlier in the year in Memphis.
