

Four men hit in the double figures last night as Florida State's basketball team swept past Spring Hill by a surprising 100-70 score.

Hugh Durham, Seminole captain, was the high scorer with 27 points. Don Bates, FSU's other starting guard, hit for 21. Jim Liteky and Jim Savage got 12 apiece.

It was the second straight victory for the Seminoles after an initial loss to Kentucky.

FSU meets Wake Forest tomorrow night at Winston-Salem. The Tribe plays Florida here Saturday.

Florida State jumped to a 9-0 lead and never fell behind as Durham and Bates got hot. Closest the Badgers ever got to the FSU team was four points, at 26-22.

Of the 234 points that FSU has chalked up in three games this season, Durham and Bates have accounted for 139.

Leigh Gorman, 6-4 center for Spring Hill, was the Badgers' top man with 20 points, followed by Jim Carney with 14 and Al Irato with 12.

Carney was the leading rebounder in the game with 11. Center Dan Bolts was high for FSU with 10.

The Badgers had a .800 percentage from the free throw line, sinking 20 of 25 attempts. Irato hit on eight of eight.

The Seminoles had a .628 free throw percentage. Liteky was tops, making all eight of his attempts. For the season Liteky has made 17 of 19. Durham got five out of eight to run his record to 31 in 35 attempts.

The Seminoles had a .478 percentage from the floor. Spring Hill had .304.

At the half, the Seminoles held a 45-31 lead. The Badgers, led by Gorman and Carney, tried a comeback but fell far short.

With three minutes left in the game FSU Coach Ned Kennedy cleared his bench.

Joe Williams, veteran guard from Tallahassee, scored in his first game for Spring Hill.

The loss gave Spring Hill a 2-2 record. The Badgers lost to Alabama, hold victories over St. Bernard and Tampa.
