An overlow crowd in Tully Gym last night saw Florida State whip the University of Florida cagers 80-62, in what was the first win over the Gators in Seminole basketball history.

The win also marked the first time that the Florida hoopsters had been beaten by a state team since 1953 when Miami turned the trick. Previous to last night's loss, the Florida basketball team has beaten 24 straight state foes.

GATOR STREAK

Florida had bested the Seminoles in the four games they had played up till last night.

The last two times the Gators won was in 1956 and 57 when they won by two and one points respectively.

The win gives Florida State a 3-2 mark for the season with other triumphs being over Spring Hill and Furman. The losses came at the hands of Kentucky and Wake Forest.

For the Gators, it was the second defeat of the season, the other one coming by way of a 66-63 loss to Georgia. They hold victories over Erskine College, Stetson and Rollins.

The Gators, guided by Coach John Mauer, utilized the fast break most of the evening, but the taller Seminoles were able to stay with Florida and control the backboards besides.

Coach Mauer had to abandon his two platoon system in favor to spot substitution as he had to leave his top men in the game to keep up with the Seminoles.

The fast break used by Florida was spoiled by the ballhawking of Durham and Don Bates who stole the ball consistently all during the game.

Mauer said, "PSU played a very fine game, they have improved a lot from last year, it was agood team, to good foreus."

Florida State's Kennedy remarked, "That ball club that took the court against Florida was one that wanted to win, and they did." It was an extremely fine team of fort, We are playing better as a team every game we play."

"The difference tonight was that our inside men were hitting, and if you want to beat a team like Florida, your inside has to be town."
