Don Bates, on a recent hot wireak, poured in 29 points to pace the Seminoles, Bates, jundor guard from Jasper, Ind., hit 13 field goals, only one short of tying the school single-game record of 14 by Ham Wernke against Tampa in 1953.

Hugh Durham, on a late-season slump, managed 16 points and forward Jim Liteky scored 11 for the Seminoles. Murray's Pete Wilkins collected 24 points and Jack Darnall counted 22.

The teams swapped baskets during the first half, with Murray leading at intermission by a single point at 41-40. But FSU center Dan Boltz fouled out with eight minutes to play and forward Charlie Tinsley followed him to the bench soon after to allow Murray to control the boards.

The hosts hit a torrid 50 erect of their shots, canning 35, of 30. FBU fired a respectable 30 of 59 for 44 per cent. Murray outsebounded the Tribe, 49-41, and hit 26 fre throws to 11 for the Seminoles.
