

NEW ORLEANS, La.—Loyola's big Wolfpack dropped a 55-55 tie with 4½ minutes left and went on to turn back Florida State, 71-64, in the Jesuits' season opener here last night.

The Seminoles rallied to tie it at 52-all and 55-55 before

For the second straight night, the Seminoles held their own from the floor but a wide margin in free throws proved their downfall. FSU outshot Loyola 24-26 from the field but the Wolfpack had a 31-16 margin on foul shots.

SOPH'S SCORING

The Seminoles made a surprisingly strong opening performance against LSU at Baton Rouge Tuesday in an 89-78 losing cause.

Sophomores continued last night to provide most of the scoring punch, getting 52 of the Tribe's 64 points. Soph Rufus Ashworth led all scorers with 23 points. Sophs Ray Swain and Dave Fedor scored 17 and 11 points, respectively, before fouling out.

After a slow start, Ashworth hit a one-hander to push FSU out front, 19-18. It stayed almost that close until Fedor fouled out with 12:59 left in the game.

Swain left the game on person-

als with 6:21 remaining. Loyola took charge at that point to pull away for its seven-point victory.

It was the 13th Loyola victory in 18 starts against Bud Kennedy's Seminoles.

The Seminoles hit 16 of their 22 free throws but Loyola had a whopping total of 31 out of 41. Officials taxed FSU with 26 personal fouls against 15 for Loyola.

GOOD REBOUNDING

Fedor and Swain helped FSU's cause with strong rebounding. Fedor picked off 13 rebounds and Swain contributed seven.

Loyola had four players in double figures, with Harriman Morgan scoring 19 points. Pensacola's Art Radvilas scored 14 points and collected 13 rebounds for the winners.

The Seminoles return to Tallahassee today to begin preparation for their Saturday night game with Florida in Gainesville. The Gators opened last night with a victory over Tampa.
