

If sophomore Dave Fedor has many more nights in his next two seasons like the one he had last night, Florida State basketball fans might well start calling him "Big D."

Fedor, 6-8 southpaw smoothie from Zephyrhills, set two individual records and tied another as the Seminoles swamped Rollins, 66-30, in Tully Gym.

Fedor rammed in 37 points that included a single-game record 15 field goals and pulled down 23 rebounds to pace the Tribe to its 100-point verdict over the Tars.

The 15 field goals erased the former mark of 14 held by Ham Wernke since 1952. The 23 rebounds tied Fedor's own single-game record set against Jacksonville University earlier this season and pushed his season total to 300 rebounds in 20 games.

No Seminole player ever topped 300 rebounds in a single cam-

paign. With five games to play, Fedor is averaging 19.2 points and 15.5 rebounds.

Fedor sank the record-breaking field goal with eight seconds to play and it was fitting that the basket pushed FSU over the 100-point mark for the first time in 79 games.

The Seminoles gave Fedor plenty of support, with all 11 players used by Coach Bud Kennedy scoring. Recent squad additions Bill Cotten and Roger Freudenstein scored 15 and 13 points, respectively.

Rollins held a 3-2 lead but was out of it after that. The Seminoles sprinted to a 51-25 halftime lead and the score might have been more decisive had it not been for Rollins' Dick Bishop.

Bishop scored 25 of the Tars' 38 points, getting 18 points in the last half.

The taller Seminoles outrebounded Rollins, 66-30, with the entire Tar team getting only two more rebounds than Fedor.

Fedor was hot from the start, bagging seven field goals and 17 termission. Taking 27 shots from

the floor, Dave made good on 54 per cent of them.

It was the seventh win in 20 games for the young Seminoles, who face Furman and Greenville, S.C., tomorrow night. FSU now has won 11 straight games from Rollins and 15 out of 17 overall.

Fedor has scored in double figures in each of FSU's 20 games this season. His highest previous total was 28 points in a Seminole victory over South Carolina. He hit eight points in the first half. He hit eight field goals and 20 points after in-
