

CHARLESTON, S.C. —
High-scoring forward Gary Daniels, limited to 24 points in three previous games with Florida State, dunked in 30 points last night to fire The Citadel to a 79-66 basketball triumph over the Seminoles.

The Cadets overcame a one-point Seminole lead at halftime to snap the Tribe's winning streak at five games. The loss, only the second in nine games for FSU, leaves the Seminoles with an 11-8 season record. The Citadel has a 15-7 standing.

AVENGE LOSS

Out to avenge an 83-77 loss to FSU at Tallahassee 12 days ago, The Citadel took charge in the final half after the score had been tied six times and the lead changed hands five times.

Hitting mostly on driving layups and close-in shots, Daniels made 11 of 20 field goal attempts and eight of 13 free throws. Checked with 13 points at Tallahassee, Daniels is one of the nation's leading scorers with a 22-point-plus average.

Dave Fedor, FSU's 6-6 star, hit double figures—but barely—for the 44th straight game as a Seminole. Fedor finished with 12 points, two less than FSU team leader Ray Swain, who bagged 14.

Fedor pulled down 18 rebounds, though, to continue as one of the nation's top 10 rebounders. FSU led the Cadets on the boards, 49-46.

EARLY LEAD

A noisy crowd of 3,200 looked on as FSU stacked up a 33-28 lead on Tim Edney's jump shot with 57 seconds left in the opening half. But The Citadel closed it to 33-32 at intermission and Daniels' layup at the outset of the final half gave the Cadets new life.

With 5:48 left, The Citadel had an eight-point lead and the final margin—13 points—was the biggest for the Cadets.

The Citadel canned 44.6 per cent of its shots from the floor while FSU managed 40.6 per cent on field goals.

The victory left The Citadel only one game shy of the school's all-time winning mark for one season.

The Seminoles return to Tallahassee today. They entertain Furman's fast-breaking Paladins in FSU's final home game of the season on Monday night.
