

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. — Florida State's basketball team, roared back in the second half with four players hitting in double figures to whack Tennessee, 69-62, here last night.

It brought the Seminoles' record to 4-3 for the season. It was the Vols' third loss in a row.

Charlie Long and Ray Swain were high for the winners. Long pumped in 18 points, while Ray Swain had 17, 15 of them in the second half.

Others in double figures were Dave Fedor with 15 and Jack Davis with 11.

Orb Bowling led Tennessee scoring with 16. Jerry Parker pushed in 14 for the Vols.

The host club jumped to a 4-0 lead, and three times held a 6-point lead in the first half, with 17:14 left, with 11:54 left and again with 10:22 left.

Davis, a sparkplug on defense

all night, got FSU's first basket with not quite two minutes gone. Although the score was tied only once, the score changed hands four times.

FSU's first lead came when Long hit a short jump shot with 4:54 left in the first half to give the Seminoles a 22-21 advantage.

Tennessee's biggest lead came with 17:09 left in the game, when Charlie Moss hit a corner jump shot to give the Vols a 43-36 advantage.

FSU gained the lead to stay with 8:54 left on Swain's jump shot to make it 50-49.

The Seminoles three times held a lead of seven points late in the game.

FSU hit a sparkling 53 per cent from the floor, 77.3 per cent from the foul line. Tennessee got 42.2 per cent from the field, 66.7 per cent on free throws.

The host club outrebounded FSU, 42-28.

Seminole Coach Bud Kennedy praised the work of firey guard Jack Davis. "He had the best night in years," Kennedy stated.
