

The biggest lead by either team was the winning margin of six, made possible by Donnie Mahaffey's layup with eight seconds left.

Fifteen seconds earlier, Gary Burniski sank two free throws for Clemson, helping put the host club out of range.

FSU's Jack Davis, taking one of the two shots he tried from the floor all night, had pulled his club within two points at 71-69 with 45 seconds remaining.

Brennan hit half of his 22 field goal attempts, made good on four of five efforts from the foul line, yet he didn't get a single rebound.

The Seminoles' all-round ace Dave Fedor was high for his club with 22 points, making good on eight of 18 from the floor and all six of his tosses from the foul line. He pulled down seven rebounds.

Sophomore Dale Reeves dump-

ed in 19 points, hitting a sparkling seven of nine field goals and cashing in on five of eight from the foul line. He had eight rebounds to lead both teams in this department.

ie n d For Clemson, Manning Privette and Nick Milasnovich had 16 points apiece.

9 d r The Florida State, leading the nation in field goal percentage with over .500 last weekend, hit on 48.1 per cent of its shots from the floor, under Clemson's 49.2 per cent.

Clemson hit 53.8 per cent of its field goals the first half, all 10 of its free throw attempts.

s d The Tigers ended with 71.4 per cent accuracy at the foul line, to FSU's 63.3 per cent.

2 r The score was tied 11 times. The lead changed hands 12 times.

At one point late in the second half, the lead changed hands five times within 2½ minutes. At the end of that period, Brennan hit a jump shot with 4:54 left to put Clemson ahead to stay.

Davis came through with a clutch shot with 3:56 left to pull his team within one point, but that was the closest FSU could get.

FSU's biggest lead in the first half came when Swain made a layup with 15:30 left to make it 9-4. Clemson led, 36-32, with 2:09 left on Brennan's jump shot.
