

OKLAHOMA CITY — Unheralded Charlie Long poured in 34 points and Florida State's basketball team nudged by Oklahoma City, 81-79, here last night.

The victory put the Seminoles' overall record at 8-7. held a 71-64 advantage with six minutes left.

Long hit 14 of 20 from the field, six of eight from the foul line. But Koper and Tsoodle teamed up to pull the Chiefs up close, however it took Jones' driving layup to the buzzer to pull Oklahoma City to within two points.

Dave Fedor and Ray Swain also hit in double figures for the winners. Fedor finished with 20 points, hitting seven of 16 from the floor and all six of his foul shots.

Swain cashed in on eight of 13 from the field and sank his only free throw attempt for a total of 17.

Fedor and Swain pulled down 12 rebounds apiece as FSU won the battle of the boards, 39-33.

High for the host club was Gene Tsoodle, who hit a rousing 10 of 14 attempts from the field, four of five from the free throw line for 24 points.

Larry Jones had 21 for Oklahoma City, hitting eight of 21 from the field, all five from the free throw line. Bill Hill hit 13 for the Chiefs.

Oklahoma City held a 49-46 halftime lead, but the Seminoles jumped to an early lead at the start of the second half. FSU
