

Final statistics on the Florida State basketball team show the Seminoles with a field-goal-shooting percentage of 51.2—which is expected to be good enough to rank them No. 1 nationally in this department.

Leading the way in percentage was senior center Ray Swain of Jacksonville. The 6-4 co-captain hit a school-record 57.3 per cent from the field. He broke his own record of 53.7 percent, set last season.

Honorable mention All-American Dave Feder led the Tribe in rebounds and total points (470), had a 20.4 per game points average. The 6-6 Zephyrchills product finished his varsity career with 1,453 points, an average of 20.2 per game. The senior co-captain played every varsity game for three seasons and scored in double figures in all 72 contests.

Feder led FSU in free throw

percentage (78.4), hitting 78 per cent for his three years of varsity competition. From the field, Feder hit 52.2 percent this season, with 49.8 percent over the three year span. Swain hit one percent higher (50.8) for the three seasons.

Highlights of the 15-8 season included a fine showing against top-ranked Ohio State (72-57, a brief first half lead, 22-21, half-time score of 29-24) and Wisconsin (64-63), two victories over state-

rivals Florida (85-71, 79-56), Miami (65-60, 83-80) and Tampa (91-71, 123-92) and a win at Auburn (56-52).

The Tribe also had an 11-point second half lead over NIT-bound Houston before succumbing, 84-76, on the Cougars court. FSU and Kentucky were the only teams to defeat Florida and Auburn in its backyard this season, and the Tribe had the lone Woodruff Hall victory over Georgia's Bulldogs.
