AUBURN, Ala.—Florida State lost its first basketball game of the early season to the never-behind

Auburn Tigers 92-78 Saturday night.

Led DeFore, 6-6 junior forward for the Tigers, led all scorers with 28 points, followed by Seminole Pete Gonzalez who finished with 16.

Auburn jumped to a quick lead on field goals by 6-7 captain Freddie Guy and Larry Cart which helped in posting Auburn's second win in as many games.

The Tigers controlled the boards, gathering 45 rebounds to the Seminoles' 30 and hit on 51.7 per cent of its field goal attempts to FSU's 40.4. Gonzalez and Ron Malmen tried unsuccessfully to get FSU back in the game in the late stages with outside shooting, but were overcome by a staunch Tiger defense. At the free throw line, Auburn out-hit the Seminoles, 83 to 48 per cent. Gary Schull, a high - pointer for the Seminoles, fouled out with 10:43 left in the game but was still second high scorer for FSU with 12 points.

The Seminoles have today off before clashing with tough Alabama tomorrow night at Tuscaloosa. FSU is now 2-1 end the season. Florida State's freshmen cagers fell victims to the Baby Tigers' torrid shooting from the foul line, losing 76-57 despite having a one-point lead at the half.

The Baby Seminoles outscored Auburn 20-19 from the floor, but the foul shots proved fatal. Russ Forkey and Darrel Stewart led the Floridians with 16 points each. Tops for the Tigers was Ed Howell, with 19.
