

TULSA, Okla. — Center Gary Schull scored a game-winning basket as the final gun sounded here Saturday night to lead touring Florida State to a thrilling 74-72 come-from-behind victory over Tulsa University.

After trailing by as much as 11 points, the Seminoles fought back and with one second remaining and the score knotted at 72-all, called time out.

Forward Bill Peacock passed to Schull under the basket and the 6-7 junior from Pompano Beach took the ball and tipped it in as time ran out.

Guard Bobby Lovell, who sat out the Seminoles' game Tuesday night against Tennessee in Memphis, entered Saturday night's tilt with five minutes gone and scored 16 points in the first half to keep Florida State in contention.

Tulsa took a 45-37 halftime lead on the hot shooting of 6-4 forward Carlos Gripado.

Florida State took the lead on a field goal by Lovell with 11:38 remaining.

From that point the Seminoles led by five points on three separate occasions.

Jerry Shirley hit a free throw at 4:25 showing on the clock after officials had called a technical foul on the crowd. Officials called the technical because fans protested too loudly a foul called against a Golden Hurricane player.

Tulsa forward Bob Fedorko hit two free throws and a jump shot in the final 1:11 minutes to tie the score at 72-72.

The Seminoles called two time outs, the first to advance the ball to mid-court. From there, they called another break to work out the winning play.

Lovell, bidding to regain his starting position, led the winners with 22 points while Shirley, who fouled out with two minutes remaining, had 16 points.

The Seminoles, now 5-4, meet first-seeded DePaul of Chicago Monday night at 7:30 (CST) in the first round of the 29th annual All-College Tournament at Oklahoma City.
