

Senior forward Jerry Shirley set a school record for career free-throw percentage in his three years at Florida State.

A 6-6, 225-pounder who led the 1964-65 team in scoring, Shirley ended his career with 161 free throws made in 198 attempts, an .813 percentage.

The mark eclipsed the record of .781 set by all-time scoring leader Jim Oler in 1952-53. Oler is now coach at Brevard Junior College.

Shirley, who finished his career last week with 28 points in an 85-83 victory over Georgia, scored 915 points in 1962-65.

As a junior, he set the school record for one-season free throw percentage with .868 (59 of 68), but his percentage fell to .814 this season. It placed him third on the team for this season, behind junior guard Ken Leakey (.962) and sophomore forward Ron Malmen (.814).

Another graduating senior, guard Bobby Lovell, led in shooting from the field. He hit

38 of 173 shots for a field-goal percentage of .511. The record is .573, set in 1961-62 by Ray Swain.

Junior center Gary Schull, last year's points leader, took down 273 rebounds to top the 64-65 team, and finished second in scoring with 325 points. Malmen was third with 322.

Schull was voted all-tourney at the Vanderbilt Invitational.

Shirley, who plans a career in the U. S. Air Force, Lovell, who will join the U. S. Peace Corps, and guard Pete Gonzalez ended three-year tenures at Florida State. The trio helped lead the team to 16 victories, most by an FSU team since 1956.

High points of the season were victories here over Florida, Miami, Georgia Tech, and Auburn, and rousing wins on the road over Baylor (for third place at Nashville) and over Tulsa on a last-second basket by Schull.

Darrel Stewart, a 6-1 guard from Seelyville, Ind., led the 1964-65 Florida State freshman team in scoring with 314 points for a 15.7 average. Jim Lytle, who shot .528 from the field, and Russ Forkey had 281 points apiece.

Lytle is a 6-0 guard from Bright, Ind. and Forkey a 6-4 forward from Spencer, Mass.
