ATHENS, Ga. — First in the nation in free-throw shooting a couple of weeks ago, Florida State's basketball team hit only seven of 19 from the foul line here last night and lost to Georgia 63-57.

The Seminoles, now 5-5 for the season, were 4th nationally in free-throw percentage going into the game.

Georgia, now rolling at 5-2, broke a 49-49 tie with six minutes remaining, whipped to a 57-51 lead and held on.

It was close all the way.
Georgia moved well early
on Lee Martin's shooting. FSU
pulled to a 19-19 tie on a
Ken Doyle tip in and then
led 23-22 on Jim Lyttle's
jumper.

Georgia took over again, 24-23, just before a foul was called on the Bulldogs. Coach Ken Rosemond's protest on the action drew a technicalfoul call from an official. Boyle missed two foul shots. The crowd of 7,000 boodd so violently that Doyle was awarded an additional technical. The sophomore missed all three shots. Bill Peacock came in to shoot the original technical for a 24-24 tie.

The Seminoles were ahead at the half 30-29,

With starters Ray Jeffords and Jim Youngblood in foul trouble early in the second half, Georgia turned to substitute Dwayne Powell, who got hot, poured in 10 of his 14 points after intermission.

Bill Glenn and Lyttle, the latter held to just two first-half points, led the Seminoles in the final portion. Glenn, a Tallahassee sophomore, led FSU scoring with 14 points.

Lyttle, along with Peacock, got 10. Top scorer Gary Schull put in 13.

The Seminoles led 36-34 with 14:39 left. Georgia went into a stall after gaining its 57-51 lead, and despite Glenn's three straight long jumpers FSU couldn't close the gap.

Georgia led in rebounding, 41 to 38, in percentage from the field, 48.1 to 43.1, in free-throw percentage, 63 to 36.8.

Jerry Waller, with 13 points and 12 rebounds, was a stick-out for the Bulldogs.

The Seminoles return home to meet Miami on Friday night.
