TAMPA—Florida State resumed its season-ending fury here Saturday night as the Seminoles outscored Tampa 99-70.

The game was marred by three technical fouls against the Tampa bench and numerous incidents of paper-cup throwing by the partisan crowd.

Despite seeing limited action, Gary Schull again led the Seminole attack with 23 points, and paced FSU on the boards with 11 rebounds.

Both teams were cold from the floor as more than a minute went by before Schull broke the scoring ice with a jumper from the key. Another minute went before Ray Wacenske tied it for Tampa with a driving layup, but that was the last time the Spartans came close.

Nine consecutive points by the Tribe broke the game open as the Seminoles waltzed to a 51-30 halftime lead. A minute before halftime a technical foul was called against the Spartans and Bill Peacock dropped in the free throw.

The second half was a carbon-copy of the first with the Tribe dominating play and pulling further and further ahead. At one point the Seminoles led by as much as 35 points.

With 8:55 left, Tampa Coach Bob Lavey was charged with two technical fouls and when Ken Leakey went to the free throw line to take the shots, ice filled paper cups rained down on the floor.

Leakey nevertheless connected on both, and the fans quickly quieted when the referee threatened to halt the game.

For the second game in a row the Seminoles fell one point shy of the century mark, as Ken Doyle put in two free throws with no time remaining on the clock.

The Seminoles play Miami tomorrow night in the Miami Beach Convention Hall.
