Auburn hit on 11 free throws and added three field goals in the last eight minutes to wrap up the Tigers' fifth victory against four defeats. TSU is 2-6. Nordholz broke a 41-41 tie just before haldtime with two field goals which gave the Orimson Tide a 45-41 lead, and Alabama led the rest of the way. Nordholz led Alabama scoring with 20 points, followed by Turn-

er with 16 and Elliott with 15. Wayne Kreis was high for Texas Christian with 25, followed by Mickey McCarty with 15. Alabama led by as many as 12 points in the second half before a surge by the Herned Frogs closed the gap to four points However; the Texas beam could close the gap to further.
