

MOBILE, Ala. (AP) — Mike Nordholz sank a 25-foot field goal just as the final horn sounded Wednesday night to give Alabama an 80-79 basketball victory over Florida State in the Mobile Classic.

The victory, coupled with Auburn's identical 80-79 edge over Texas Christian in the first game, gave the Alabama host teams a sweep in the classic.

With three seconds left in the game and the clock stopped, Alabama was behind 79-78. The ball was thrown in to Nordholz who fired at the basket, scoring without touching the rim.

Florida State, which had trailed through most of the game, tied the score and went ahead with about 7 minutes to go. With 11 seconds left, the Seminoles' Bill Glenn hit a field goal to put FSU in front 79-78, but the Seminoles knocked the ball out of bounds to set the stage for

e Nordholz' game-saving shot.

d Nordholz led Alabama scoring with 21 points, followed by Guy Turner with 17 and Tom Jones with 15. Glenn and Dick Danford were high for the Seminoles with 23 each.

- Tee Faircloth sank a field goal in the last minute of play to give Auburn the victory over Texas Christian.

Auburn led by 14 at halftime, but led by sharpshooting Mickey McCarty who tallied 28 points, the Horned Frogs whittled away the lead after intermission.

Texas Christian finally tied the score at 68-68 with little more than five minutes left. Auburn then forged ahead 75-70
