

Florida State's basketball team tied or bettered 18 school records, received their first NCAA Tournament bid and recorded the second most victories in school history during the season just ended.

Coach Hugh Durham's boys fell to East Tennessee 79-69 in the NCAA, winding up with a 19-8 mark. With three starters returning, a group of outstanding freshmen plus with a top redshirt, Durham is looking forward to next year.

Only one individual record fell. Sophomore center Dave Cowens cracked the season rebounding mark by pulling down 456 to top the record of 451 by Rick Bennson set during the 1954-55 season in 26 games.

The most impressive single game mark to fall was the most points for a contest. Against LSU in the Milwaukee Classic, the Seminoles poured

through 130 points, bettering the record of 123 against Tampa in 1962.

Other single game records bettered, with the old mark following, include:

Most points, both teams, 230 vs LSU (215 vs Tampa, 1962); most points at home, 122 vs Miami (121 vs Tampa, 1965); most points in a half, 72 vs LSU (67 vs Tampa, 1962);

most points on neutral floor, 130 vs LSU (108 vs Furman, 1957); most field goals attempted, 115 vs LSU (96 vs Miami, 1953); most rebounds, 88 vs LSU (73 vs Florida Southern, 1966).

Season records broken or tied: most games played, 27 (27 in 1950-51); longest winning streak, seven straight (seven, 1961-62); most points, 2,438 (2,295 in 1954-55, 26 games); highest scoring average, 90.3 (88.3 in 1954-55); most field goals made, 956 (794 in 1954-55); highest free throw percentage, 72.9 (72.7 in 1963-64); most points allowed opponents, 2,118 (2,071 in 1956-57; most times scoring 100 or more points, nine (three in 1954-55 and 1961-62).

One other individual record was tied. Cowens' 103 personal fouls equaled teammate Dick Danford's high set during the 1966-67 campaign.
