

TONIGHT'S GAME

Two of the South's top independent basketball teams meet for the third time this season tonight when Florida State plays host to sixth-ranked Jacksonville.

In the two previous meetings, the Dolphins won 114-108 in the finals of the Civitan Classic and 83-65 in a regular scheduled contest. Last season, when both clubs were nationally ranked, the teams split a pair of games, each club winning on its home court.

Jacksonville comes into tonight's contest with an 18-2 record and a 12-game winning streak. Wake Forest handed the Dolphins their first defeat, 78-77, in the Gold Coast Classic finals. Their other loss was administered by Western Kentucky, 97-84.

College basketball's leading rebounder, 7-2 Artis Gilmore, will start at the low post for Jacksonville. The Chipley, Fla., senior is averaging 23.0 points and 22.9 rebounds.

Another seven-footer, Pembroke Burroughs, will be working from the high post. He averages 12.5 points and eight rebounds. On the wings will be 6-7 Ernie Fleming, 17.0 points and five rebounds, along with 6-2 Harold Fox, 17.5 points. Directing the attack will be senior playmaker Vaughn Wedeking, averaging 12.0 points.

For the Seminoles, now 16-6 and making their final Tully Gym appearance for this season, senior Vernell Ellzy starts at the low post. Ellzy is the team's third-leading scorer with a 14.5 average and the second-leading rebounder with an 8.5 average.

At the high post will be 6-11 Reggie Royals, the team's top rebounder with a 15.0 average. The Whiteville, N.C., sophomore is the Seminoles' second-leading scorer with an 18.7 mark.

On the wings will be Ron King and Rowland Garrett. King (23.1) is fresh off a 46-point night against Georgia Southern which broke the Florida State single-game scoring record. Garrett, a junior, is averaging 13.0 points and 8.1 rebounds.

At the point will be Otto Petty with a 7.6 scoring average. The Louisville, Ky., sophomore has 184 assists for the season.
