FOUR STRONG TEAMS BID FOR NCAA BERTHS

Regardless of the thrills that might lie ahead the next three weekends, hardly anything can match the excitement and tension that accompanied Ohio University and Eastern Kentucky to berths in the NCAA Mid-East Regionals.

Neither school followed easy paths to Knoxville. Both finished their seasons deadlocked for their conference championships and were forced into playoffs to determine their leagues' NCAA representatives. Ohio nosed out Toledo, 69-67, Tuesday night for the Mid-American Conference nod.

The Ohio Valley Conference berth was decided in a two-day tournament involving Eastern, Morehead and Western Kentucky. Morehead eliminated Western Tuesday night but fell to Eastern, which had drawn an opening bye, Wednesday night. It was the Colonels' second victory in five days over Morehead.

A month ago, Marquette would have rated a solid choice to roll through the Mid-East region with ease, in games both at Knoxville this week and Dayton next week. The loss of All-America Jim Chones to professional basketball two weeks ago has cast doubt now on Marquette's ability to pull itself together for the tough tournament grind.

It's impossible to gauge the effect one player's defection would have, but if Marquette's loss to Detroit by 21 points Feb. 26 is any indication, Chones' departure has taken a heavy toll. The talented Warrior probably rated as close to a sure-fire All-America as any player on the collegiate scene this year.

Florida State, too, has suffered a stunning setback since its selection to an at-large berth. The Seminoles were shoved around quite rudely by Cincinnati Saturday night, sustaining an 88-64 loss.

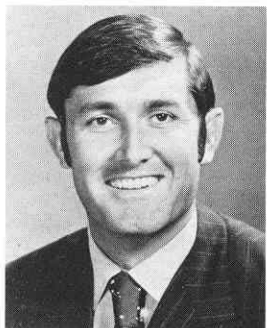
The game pitting Marquette against Ohio will begin at 2:10 p.m. today. Florida State and Eastern Kentucky should tip off at shortly after 4.



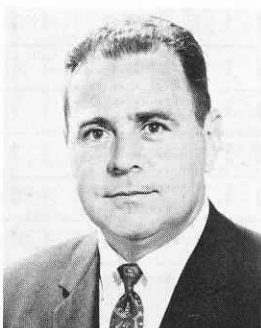

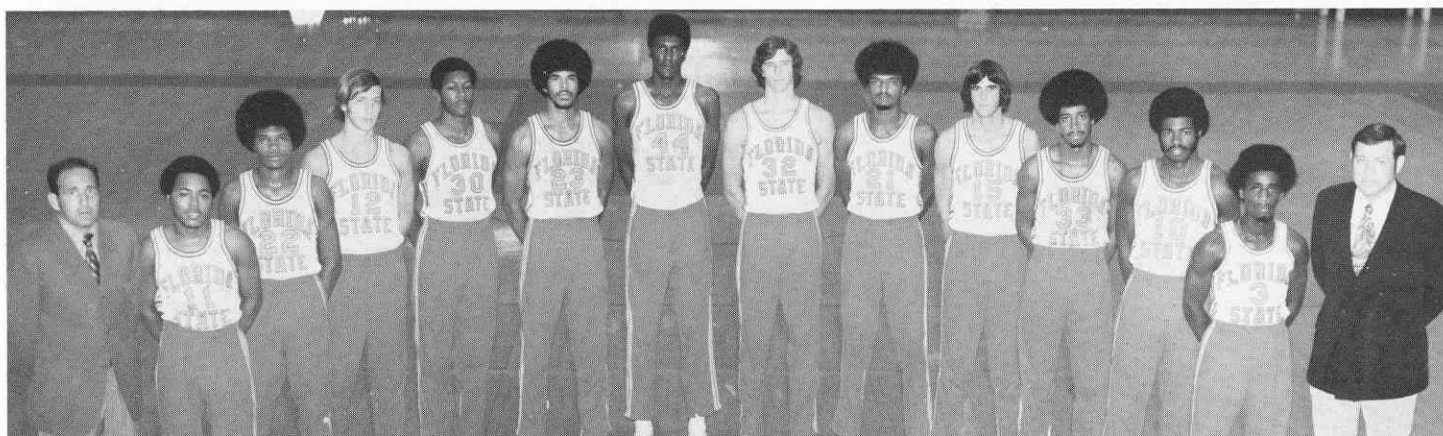

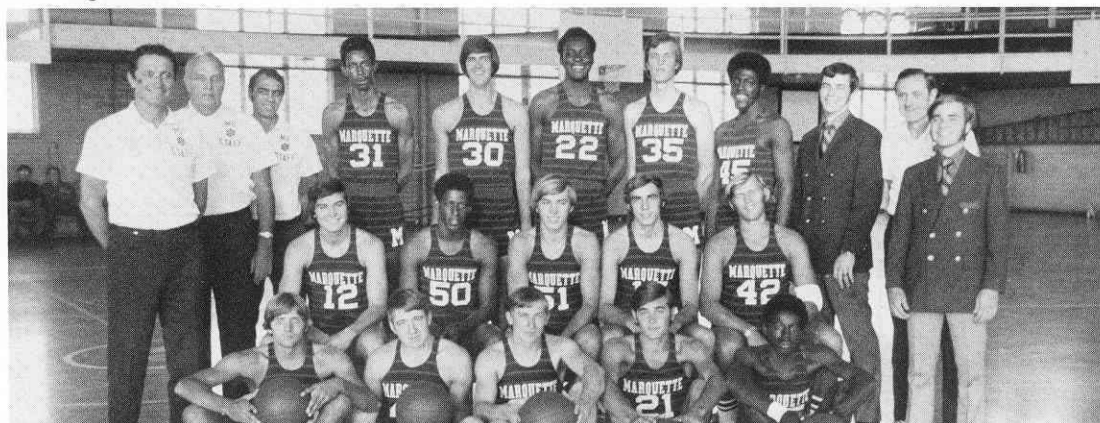
