RENEGADES vs. FLORIDA AGM IROSH FLORIDA STATE vs. GEORGIA SOUTHERN 5:15 7:30

Welcome to Tully Gym and the season opener for the nation's second ranked basketball team! Tonight marks a new era for college basketball in the Deep South--never before has a team from this part of the country begun a season ranked so high. Tonight the Seminoles open defense of that ranking against the Georgia Southern Eagles. Coach J.E. Rowe's club is a newcomer to University Division basketball but the Statesboro, Ga., school is building a fine athletic program.

While you're watching tonight's game you will notice a few changes in the rules of play. The most noticeable change involves fouls. Teams will not go to the free throw line for common fouls until the bonus rule is in effect. Fouls in the act of shooting, intentional fouls, flagrant fouls and technical fouls will continue to be shooting fouls whenever called. When a common foul before the seventh team foul is called the ball will be awarded to the offended team.

Those fans who like to keep their own scorecard will be interested in the following NCAA Basketball Scoring Rules Interpretations, which were added this year:

FIELD GCALS: An individual player will no longer be charged with a field goal attempt if his field goal (or miss) is nullified by a teammate's goal tending violation. Such a field goal attempt is awarded to a new "team" category.

FREE THROWS: No free throw attempt is charged to the shooter when that attempt is nullified by a teammate's violation. Such an attempt is charged to the team category. However, if the attempt is nullified by the shooter's own violation (e.g. stepping across the line) the attempt is charged to the shooter.

REBOUNDS: If a player tips a missed shot out to a teammate, credit the tipper with RB (even if teammate fumbles the ball away). Credit RB to offensive player who intentionally taps ball toward the basket in an effort to score field goal. When players from both teams grab RB and a jump ball results, credit RB to player whose team gains possession (even if ball goes out of bounds). If a player blocks a shot credit blocker with RB unless an opposing player recovers the ball, in which case the player who recovers the ball is credited with RB. Team Rebounds are credited to team awarded the ball when: missed FGA goes out of bounds without being touched or controlled; when FTA misses the rim; after opposing player blocks a shot which goes out of bounds without being touched. Or to team that: misses the first of a two shot foul; misses a technical foul shot; misses a FGA when buzzer sounds with ball in the air.

The new freshman eligibility rule has caused a change in the status of the Seminole freshman squad which is now officially called the "B-Team". The Renegades as they are referred to have a few sophomores and juniors on the roster as well as freshmen.
