Grady lifts FSU hopes in 77-64 win

Graeg Grady got a second half reprieve and the Florida State Seminoles are alive and well following a heart-pumping 77-64 comeback victory over South Florida in Tully Gym Friday night.

Behind by one (33-32) at halftime, Coach Hugh Durham "challenged" the 6-9 junior, who took the break with four points and two rebounds.

"I almost didn't start him", Durham was to say later.

But, he did, and Grady responded with 17 second-half points and 11 rebounds for a 21-13 night and the Seminoles hiked their record to 18-7 in the season finale in Tully.

"I just felt it was time for me to get up off my - - -", said Grady, in probably coming very close to repeating what was actually said during intermission.

For the record, Grady scored seven of the Seminoles' first nine second-half points, 11 of the first 15 and had five rebounds over the first six-minutes of action.

It was enough to swing the momentum the Seminoles' way, before freshman Harry Davis made back-to-back key steals that propelled the Seminoles on top by a dozen and sealed the Brahman's doom.

But, more importantly it kept the Seminoles' hope for a post-season tournament bid alive and made the season finale at Stetson next Wednesday "the college basketball game of the year" in the state.

But, getting to the showdown with the Hatters didn't come easy and it was very much in doubt until the final seven minutes or so.

The Brahman's, now 14-10, led most of the first half and were never down by more than six until then.

But, 10 straight Seminole points, the last four coming after Davis' steals, got FSU to 63-51 with 6:26 left, and it wound up looking a lot easier than it was.

"We got a couple of fastbreaks and a couple of steals that really helped us," Durham said of the gambling plays by Davis.

"I know we're not suppose to go for the ball in the open like that," said Davis. "But I had it all the way...and I knew we had to get aggressive and make some things happen."

His big steal came at the top of the circle, and he went in alone for the layup and a 10-point lead.

Seconds later, on the Brahman's next trip down the floor, Davis got his

second steal, this time in heavy traffic and slapped the ball to Wayne Smalls, who the rest of the way for the 12-point lead.

And, by then the fans were knocking the place down for the first time all night, and for the next two minutes or so the Brahms were completely unglued after keeping their cool longer and better than any team (except Louisville) to visit a packed Tully Gym this season.

And, by the time they recovered, the Seminoles were too much in control with too little time left for the visitors.

But, they had made a game run at the Seminoles, and if it had not been for Grady, the final results would probably have been different.

"Grady did the job" said Durham, who cited the fact "we got on the boards and that was the difference between the second and first half."

The Seminoles, with Zach Perkins and Davis hauling down half their 28 rebounds in the first half, wound up with a 50-36 edge in rebounding.

But, in the first half, the Brahms scored 10 points on offensive rebounds, and Durham fingered that as the reason his Seminoles were trailing.

"We got on the boards some ourselves in the second half," he pointed out, "and we got the ball to the hot man (Grady).

Grady wound up hitting nine of 13 floor shots as the Seminoles improved to 58.1 per cent shooting in the second half for a game 46.4.
