HATTER COACHES . . .

GLENN WILKES - Head Basketball Coach

Coach, administrator, clinician, speaker, author and educator. All words to describe Coach Wilkes, the dean of basketball coaches in Florida. His four-year college record of 300-207 ranks him in the top twenty active coaches in the nation and the Hatter record of the past four years in Division I competition stands at 73-33 for a 67 per cent winning average. Coach Wilkes educational training includes the Ed. D degree from Peabody and honors he received and records he set at his Alma Mater, Mercer, still stand. He is the author of many books and articles on basketball and a frequent speaker at clinics and banquets.

JAY HOOVER - Assistant Basketball Coach

Coach Hoover has been described as "one of the brightest young coaches in America today." He was a star in both basketball and football at his Alma Mater, Ashland, during the years Ashland had their championship teams in the NCAA tournaments. He spent a year as a graduate assistant with Ray Mears at Tennessee - the same year the Vols were co-champions of the SEC - then coached the Lake Brantley High School team. This marks Coach Hoover's third season with the Hatters. He is the author of *Blueprint for Ball - Handling* and a frequent panelist at basketball clinics for coaches and players.

JOSH GILES - Assistant Basketball Coach

Coach Giles had an illustrious career as both coach and athletic director before joining the staff at Stetson. An outstanding player at North Texas State, he was head coach and AD at Shaw College in Detroit where his teams compiled a 131-42 record. During those seven seasons, his teams exceeded twenty wins during six outings and had players drafted by the pros in each of those six years. His primary responsibility for the Hatters will be recruiting in the cities and towns of the nation. His Master's Degree in Urban Studies should be an appropriate foundation for the quest.

STEVE STEINWEDEL - Graduate Assistant Basketball Coach

Steve Steinwedel joined the Stetson coaching staff last year as a graduate assistant after four years of play with Mississippi State University. A native of Seymour, Indiana, Steve graduated from Withrow High School in Cincinnati where he played both varsity basketball and cross-country. "Steve has done an excellent job for us," Coach Wilkes said, "It is difficult to find a young man coming directly out of college that can do such an outstanding job. It is like having another full-time assistant."

OTIS JOHNSON - Student Assistant Basketball Coach

Otis Johnson was a member of the 22-4 squad that shot the Hatter into orbit two years ago with the opening of Edmunds Center. During that season he led the Hatters in both scoring and rebounding and was selected in the third round of the NBA draft by the world champion Golden State Warriors. A former junior college all-star from Brevard Junior College, Otis is completing requirements for his degree in physical education.

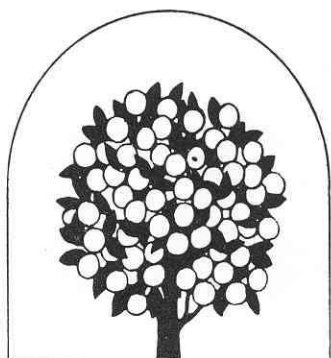

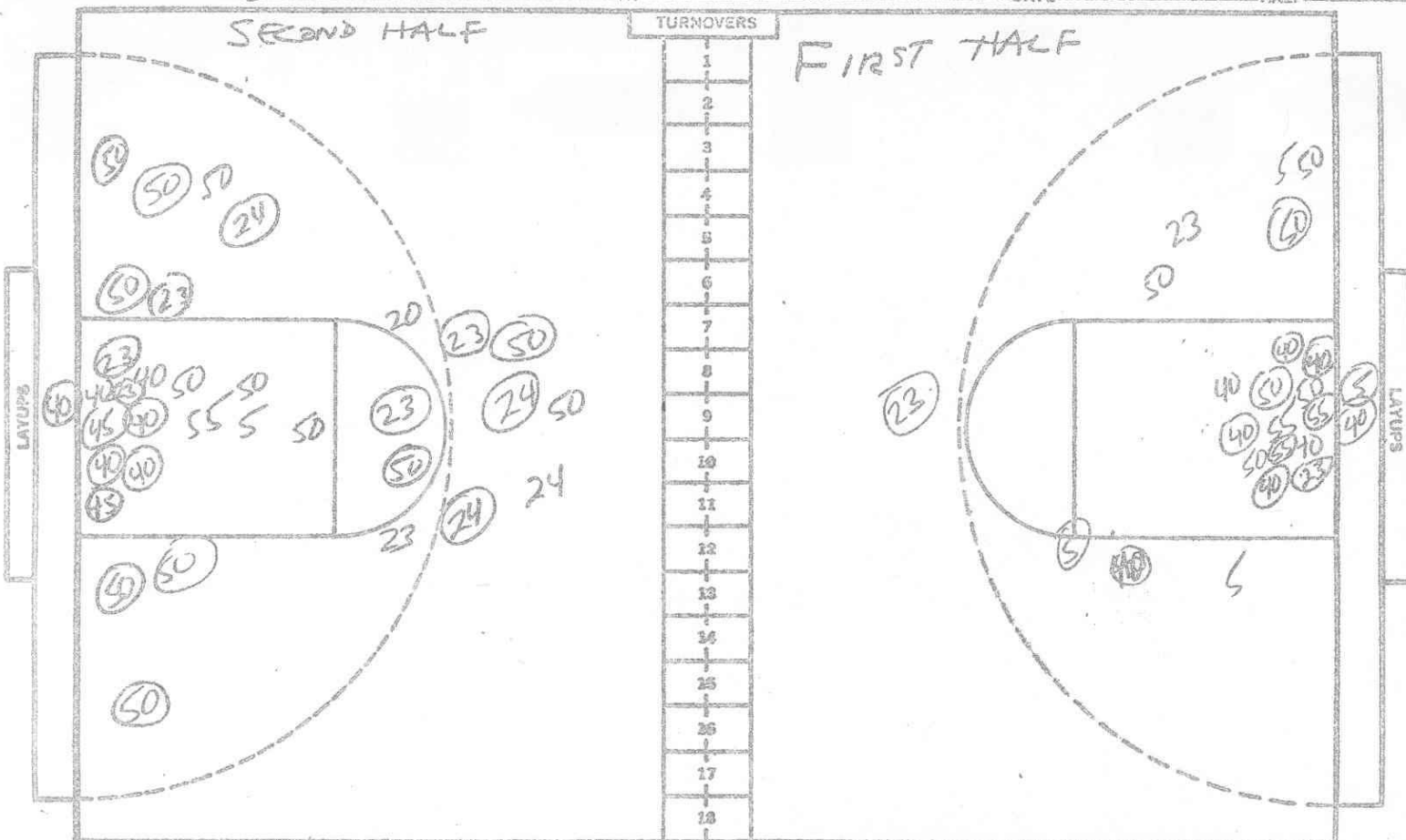

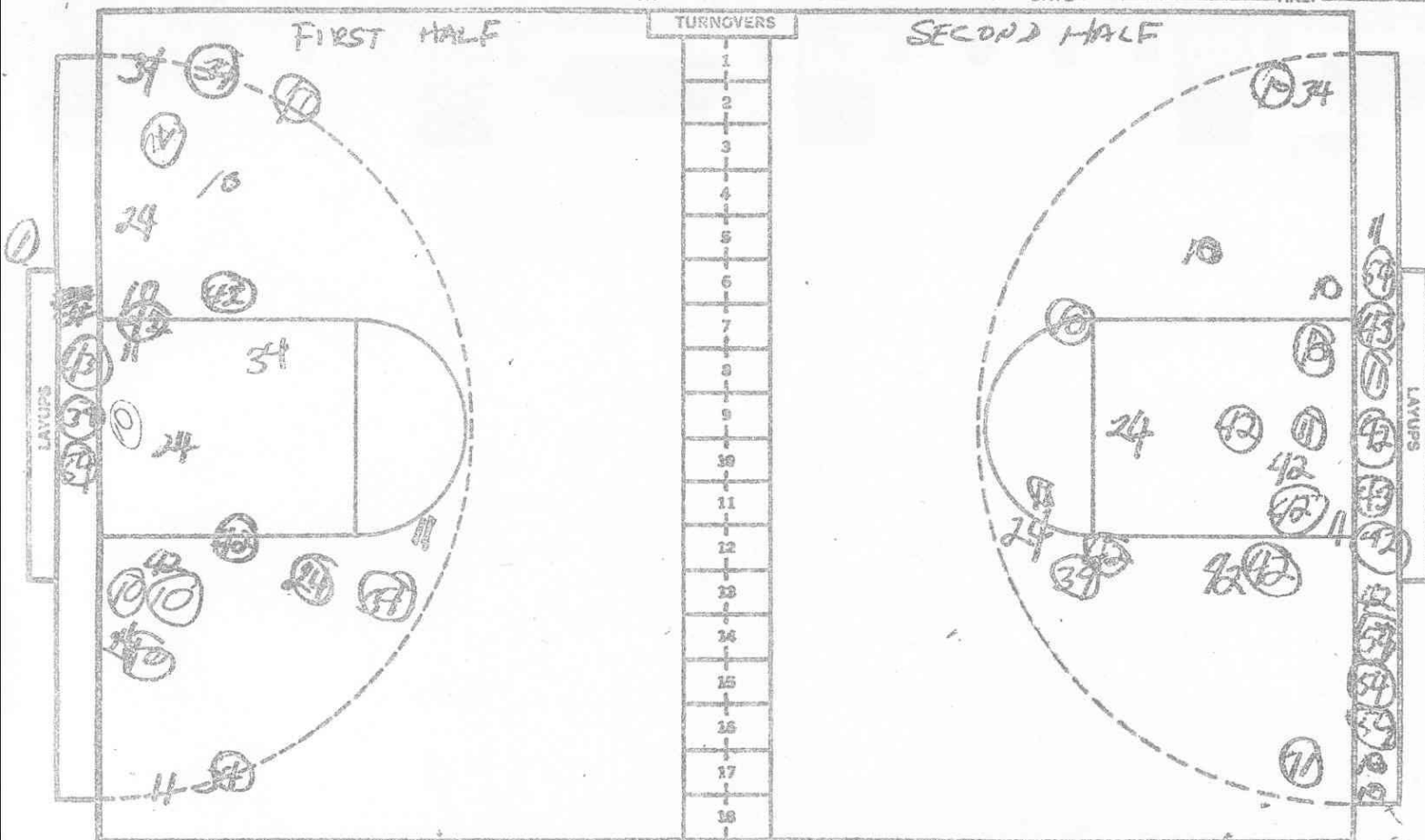
