




### Florida State meets Rollins College



# seminale basketball

When Florida State opens the 1977–78 season tonight with Rollins, Seminole fans may notice a difference in the

play of Harry Davis.

Davis, of course, is FSU's 6-7, 220-pound muscle man on the front line who scored in double figures 23 times and was the squad's second leading scorer (14.8) a year ago. He also ranked high among the nation's top field goal shooters (56.7%), lead the team in rebounding (7.8) and toured Europe last spring as a member of the USA-Metro all-star team.

So why change a player with impressive credentials like Davis's?

"We're moving Harry out to a forward position this season," says head coach Hugh Durham, who is beginning his 12th season at Florida State. "We're going to rely on Harry very heavily so we need to have him in a spot where he can help us most.

"Harry has looked very impressive during preseason both offensively and defensively. Right now he's the best player we have on the court."

While Davis has a solid hold on one of the forward positions, 6-7 sophomore Murray Brown and 6-5 freshman James Bozeman are battling it out for a starting nod. Brown played in 18 games

last season and averaged 5.2 points a game while Bozeman was a schoolboy hot-shot at Tallahassee's Florida A&M High School.

Last year's top scorer David Thompson (18.5), a preseason pick to the All-Metro team, has been sidelined with a foot injury. Thompson will see limited action as a reserve.

Four players are making serious bids for the starting guard positions according to Durham. Leading candidates are sophomores Tony Jackson and Mickey Dillard and seniors Eugene Harris and James Smith.

"Mickey and Tony both lack playing experience," says Durham. "They will need to get their experience in actual game conditions. Jackson has all the tools to be an excellent playmaker for us. He's also going to surprise some people with his shooting ability."

Rollins visits Tully Gym with one game under its belt after playing Flagler on Nov. 26 and with a new head coach.

Mark Freidinger, a former Rollins basketball and baseball star and an assistant coach for the past five years, took over for Ed Jucker, who retired with a 82-42 record.

Keeping many of the basic philosophies at Rollins, Freidinger says his teams will concentrate on man-to-man defense and conditioning.

Seniors Bob Morris, Bob Klusman and Dirk Twine along with sophomore Tim Mahoney, Kyle Rich and Bob Zyburt give the Tars ample experience. Rich and Zyburt are both 6-6 while Morris and Mahoney are the top scorers (8.8) of the group.

Veteran guards Jay Colling and Brian Campbell supply added strength and transfer Paul Callaway is the big man at

Rollins has an eight-game schedule in the first two weeks of the season which includes Florida State, NCAA semifinalist UNC-Charlotte and Davidson, so the Tars, who were 16-9 in 1977, will have their work cut out for them.

Meanwhile, FSU coach Hugh Durham has set several goals for his Seminoles to work on.

"We need to find out in the first few games just what our best combinations will be," says Durham. "We have between nine and 10 players who will play every half for us all year but we need to establish who works best with each other. Working on consistency will be another goal."

THE TEAMS: Florida State, a member of the Metro Conference, opens its basketball season tonight against Rollins (1-0), a Sunshine State Conference member.

THE RECORDS: Rollins opened its season Saturday, winning 88-68 in the home opener with Flagler.

THE COACHES: In 11 years, Hugh Durham has established a record at Florida State that is the envy of all but a few collegiate coaches. Durham, who has coached only one losing team and that came during his rookie season, has led the Seminoles to a record of 207-89. That first year an injury-riddled Tribe struggled to an 11-15 record. Since that time only one Durham coached team has won fewer than 17 games. The 1969-70 squad finished 22-3 and the 1971-72 Seminoles went to the NCAA finals.

Mark Freidinger, former Rollins basketball and baseball star, takes over the Tar basketball program this season succeeding Ed Jucker. Jucker piloted the Tars to an 82-42 log in five seasons with Freidinger as the assistant coach.

- THE SERIES: The Seminoles and Rollins will be meeting for the 21st time in a series that began in 1951. But, this is the first time the schools have played since December 2, 1973, when the Seminoles won 90-47 in Tully Gym.
- UPCOMING GAMES: Florida State plays one other game this week--Troy State Thursday in Tully Gym. The Seminoles conclude the opening three-game homestand when St. Leo visits next Monday. After that, the Seminoles play in St. Petersburg's Big Sun Tournament (Dec. 9-10) and the Birmingham Classic (Dec. 16-17).
- METRO REPORT: Four Metro Conference teams opened their seasons over the weekend.

  The only loser in the group was St. Louis, which bowed, 90-83, to Illinois State. Georgia Tech opened with a 75-58 victory over arch-rival Georgia Friday while Cincinnati bested Akron, 91-81, and Memphis State topped Northeastern Oklahoma State, 103-81, on Saturday.
