METRO CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

Florida State vs. Louisville
Saturday, March 1, 1980
Freedom Hall - Louisville, Ky.

-- The winner of tonight's Metro Conference tournament championship game will receive an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. Historically, the Metro's automatic qualifier has gone to the Midwest region and when feasible the NCAA Division I basketball committee will attempt to keep teams in their areas of natural interest. The committee, however, may also assign a team to any of the four regions in the tournament in an effort to balance the bracket.

-- Tonight's championship game will be a rematch of the 1978 Metro tournament finale between Louisville and Florida State at Riverfront Coliseum in Cincinnati. That game is considered to be the greatest game in Metro tournament history. Roger Burkman hit a jump shot with two seconds left in the game to give Louisville a 94-93 victory.

-- Louisville will be looking to become the first team in Metro history to win both the regular season and Metro tournament championships in the same year. A regular season championship was not awarded in the conference until the league's second-year of existence in 1977. Since then every regular season champion has failed to come away with the tournament title. Louisville won the regular season crown in 1977 and 1979 and was eliminated in the semifinals both times and Florida State won the Metro regular season crown in 1978 and lost to Louisville in the tournament championship game.

-- In addition, Louisville will be looking to become the first team to win the Metro tournament as the tournament's host school. In fact, this is the first time a host school has ever made it to the championship game of the tournament.

-- Total two-day attendance figure for this year's tournament is 22,720 (8,565 for the first night, 14,155 for the semifinals). The tournament attendance record is 38,190 set in 1977 at Memphis, Tenn. Tonight's attendance would have to be 15,471 or better to surpass the record.

-- Florida State's Joe Williams will be seeking his 275th career victory tonight. His lifetime career record is 274-164. Denny Crum, who ranks second in the nation among active coaches in career winning percentage, has a lifetime coaching record of 213-58.

-- Tonight's game, in addition to being televised over the Metro TV network throughout the south and southeast, is also being carried live over the ESPN television network. Ron Jacober, Oscar Robertson and Stacie Fandos will be tonight's announcing crew.

FLORIDA STATE--21-7
Pre-Game Facts & Figures

Tonight's championship matchup involving Florida State and Louisville marks the third straight year the Seminoles have reached the title game. The Tribe is still looking for its first league title, however. In 1978, the Tribe was beaten 94-93 by Louisville. Last year Virginia Tech took the league crown with a 68-60 win.

Three Seminoles who will be starting tonight were involved in the classic 94-93 game at Cincinnati on March 4, 1978. Tony Jackson scored 14 in that game, Mickey Dillard added 13 and Murray Brown was held scoreless. Both teams had outstanding shooting nights. The Seminoles connected on 42 of 71 floor shots while Louisville made 41 of 70.

Last year (March 3) the Tribe lost the title in Memphis. Murray Brown led FSU in scoring with a 30 point effort. Tony Jackson scored nine points and Bobby Parks added eight. FSU had a 28-70 showing from the floor compared to Tech's 22 of 45.

This will be the third meeting of the year between FSU and Louisville. The cards have won both outings, 79-73, here at Freedom Hall on January 27 and 83-75 last Sunday at Tully Gym in Tallahassee. Mickey Dillard has been the scoring leader for FSU in both games. He tallied 22 here in Freedom Hall and 26 in last week's defeat. Other double figure scorers for the Tribe in the Freedom Hall game were Elvis Rolle (19) and Bobby Parks (17). Dillard was backed in Tallahassee last week by Murray Brown (13) and Elvis Rolle (11).

Louisville enjoys a 10-3 advantage in its series with Florida State. Those totals include five straight wins for the Cards that date back to the 1978 championship game. That same year FSU had won both regular season games, 70-66 here at Freedom Hall, and 81-70 in Tallahassee.

Seminole guard Tony Jackson is one assist shy of 200 for the current season. When he reaches that point he will be just the second player in FSU history to have 200 assists in a single season. Otto Petty did it twice, dishing out 227 (1970-71) and 202 (1972-73).

Tony Jackson will move into third place tonight on the career listing for games played as a Seminole. Tonight's game will be his 106th in a Garnet and Gold uniform. The only players ahead of him are Eugene Harris (107 between 1973 and 1978) and Harry Davis (108 between 1974 and 1978).

Seminole forward Murray Brown now ranks seventh on the all-time scoring list for FSU. Including last night's effort vs. Cincinnati he has now scored 1,314 in his career.

Seminole guard Mickey Dillard rates 11th on the all-time scoring list for the Tribe with 1,160 markers. In scoring just seven points in last night's double overtime victory (79-69) it was the first time this season Dillard has been held to less than 10 points.

The Tribe's Murray Brown is still on course for establishing a new career record for shooting percentage. The record is .662 held by Joe Senser from West Chester State. Brown has now converted 541 of 810 for a .667 percentage.

March 1, 1980 Freedom Hall Louisville, Kentucky

Florida State is making its third straight appearance in the Metro finals. FSU has never won the Metro Basketball Championship losing to Louisville 94-93 in the 1978 finals and to Virginia Tech 68-60 in last year's finals.

Louisville is making its second appearance in the finals. They won the 1978 Championship in Cincinnati by beating the Seminoles 94-93 on late shot by Roger Burkman.

Tip controlled by: Florida State.

Game's first points: by Murray Brown at 19:28.

15:50 remaining- first time-out of the game (tv). FSU 10 U of L 6. Louisville has shot only 30% from the floor (3-10). FSU on the other hand is shooting 67% (4 of 6). The 'Noles have outrebounded Louisville 10-5.

13:00 remaining-Louisville gets first lead of game when Wiley Brown converted a pass from Griffith for a 16-14 lead.

11:03 remaining- FSU takes time-out as Louisville pads lead to 20-16. Louisville has made seven out of their last ten shots while Florida State has made three of last seven.

Louisville's Wiley Brown makes first three point play of game with 9:36 remaining. Louisville now leads 25-18.

4:02 remaining- tv time-out. Florida State 29, Louisville 27. Florida State is shooting 54% from the field (12-22) while Louisville is 13 of 32 for a 40% percentage. U of L has outrebounded FSU 16-14. The Seminoles have outscored Louisville 11-2 in last 5:34.

Half time score: Florida State 33 Louisville 29

-- FSU has lost twice to Louisville this year, however in those games Louisville led at the half.

Second half tip controlled by: Florida State

Tony Jackson hit jumper at 19:40 to open '2nd' half scoring.

17:44 remaining- FSU's Rodney Arnold makes second three point play of game for FSU. Seminoles now lead 42-35, which is their biggest lead of the game so far.

15:44 remaining - first time out of second half (tv). Louisville has scored eight straight points to take a 43-42 lead, which is their first since they led 25-23 with 8:18 remaining in first half. Griffith, upon hearing that he has been chosen Sporting News Player of the Year, has hit on four straight shots in second half.

11:27 remaining - Louisville 57 Florida State 47. Louisville has outscored the Seminoles 22-5 in the last 5:56. Griffith has now made seven straight shots in the second half. Louisville is shooting 69% in this half (11-16) while the Seminoles are 29% (5-17). Rebounds are 11 to 5 in Louisville's favor.
