




THE GAME--Today's contest marks the second time this season the two Metro foes have met. Louisville took the opening contest 98-78 on January 17. Prior to today's game, the Seminoles lost a heartbreaker 72-71 to St. Louis Wednesday on a shot with two seconds left by the Billikens Willie Becton. Prior to the St. Louis loss, the Tribe had won four straight and seven of its last nine games. One of the hottest teams in the nation, Louisville has captured its last five straight games, all at home. The Cardinals have also won nine of ten and 10 of 12. The last Cardinal loss was a 60-55 defeat at the hands of Memphis State in overtime.

THE LAST MEETING--In the Seminoles 98-78 loss at Louisville, the team trailed 12-2 early and could never come back. The win increased the Cardinals series lead to 12-3. Florida State's last win over Louisville came on February 17, 1978 at Tully Gym by a score of 81-70. Since then the Cardinals have captured the last seven meetings.

THE METRO--Today's game marks a meeting between the No. 1 and No. 3 team in the league. Louisville tops the conference with a 6-1 mark (11-8 overall), while FSU is third at 4-3 (11-7). Memphis State is sandwiched in between with a 5-2 mark (12-7).

METRO AND TV--Today's contest is the Metro Game of the Week and will be carried across the country. The Seminoles get the opportunity to become television stars when the team plays host to Cincinnati on February 14. The game is once again on Metro television.

THE COACHES--The Seminoles are led by third year mentor Joe Williams

THE COACHES--The Seminoles are led by third year mentor Joe Williams (SMU '56) who has a 286-173 record in 16 plus years of coaching. Williams previous coaching stints have been at Jacksonville (1964-70; 92-61) and Furman (1970-78; 142-87). With the Seminoles, Williams is 52-25 in two plus seasons. The Cardinals are guided by tenth year coach Denny Crum. With the Cardinals, Crum is 230-63 for a .785 winning percentage, second best among the nation's active coaches. Last season Crum's Cardinal team finished 33-3 on the way to the national championship.

METRO HONORS—Two players today have won recent Metro honors. For the Seminoles, guard Mickey Dillard was named Metro Player of the Month for January when he averaged 19.2 points in nine games. Cardinal Jerry Eaves also earned honors, capturing the Metro Player of the Week for 1/25-2/1.

JUST WONDERING—Several Seminoles are getting close in the all-time record books. The Seminoles are: Mickey Dillard field goals made 569, sixth behind David Thompson (571)...field goals attempted 1106 ninth behind Dave Cowens (1122)...games played 105 tied for fifth with Carlton Byrd...points scored, second with 1549 behind 1820 by Jim Oler. Kris Anderson is eigth in games played with 98, two behind Greg Grady. And, guard Bobby Parks is also in the games played category with 87 placing him tenth behind Jim Oler with 91.

NEXT—The Seminoles remain at home and will face St. Louis once again on Monday at 7:30. The Cardinals hit the road and head for Virginia Tech for their Monday night game.






