

Hofstra

At press time Hofstra's Flying Dutchmen are off to a 3-2 start despite numerous early season injuries.

After winning their home opener against Southampton 64-58 they lost squeaker to Lehigh 56-55. The Flying Dutchmen then came back to take Cornell 50-38 and rip Brown 91-76. Long Island U. then downed Hofstra 80-72 on the Flying Dutchmen's first road trip. Due to the program printing schedule over the holidays the results of the game with St. Francis College on December 22nd were not available.

Injuries are taking their toll on the Flying Dutchmen. Junior Robert Worrell, (6-7, 4.5 p.p.g./2.0 r.p.g.) tore cartilage in his knee against Lehigh while senior forward Chris Rankin (6-5, 8.7 p.p.g./3.0 r.p.g.) sprained ligaments in his right knee in action against Cornell. Freshman Charlie Minor (6-7, 8.3 p.p.g./5.5 r.p.g.) who led the team in rebounding the first two games, popped his left knee cap in the Brown game. Worrell and Rankin will be sidelined at least four more weeks. Minor should be ready for tonights game. Honorable mention All American forward David Taylor missed the first two games but came back quickly and now leads the team in scoring (15.5 p.p.g.) and rebounding (7.5 r.p.g.)

Senior guard Dan Rumph (6-4, 15.3 p.p.g./3.0 r.p.g.) and juniors Eric Harvey (6-2, 9.3 p.p.g/4.5 r.p.g.) and Winston Nicholas (6-4, 4.5 p.p.g./1.3 r.p.g.) switch off on ball handling chores. At center is 6-11 junior Bill Regan (1.5 p.p.g./3.3 r.p.g.) whose strength is his defensive ability (has 6 blocked shots).

Head coach Dick Berg is in his second year with the Flying Dutchmen. He has coached for 13 years and has already compiled a 290-97 lifetime record — one of the best winning percentages in the country.

Coach Berg is very active in international basketball circles having served two years as an assistant coach at the U.S. Olympic training site. He has lectured and coached in numerous foreign countries and is a member of the Nike Basketball Coaches Association and conducts clinics all over the USA.

University of Dayton

The statistics and results of the Flyers vs. Old Dominion game were unavailable at press time.


This is the 10th anniversary of the University of Dayton Inviational Tournament. During the past nine years the Flyers have won the UDIT four times, were runner-ups twice, and took third place for three straight years (1974-76). They have won the tournament three out of the last four years.

Florida State is making its third appearance in the UDIT. During the first year of the tournament in 1972 they lost in the first round to Alabama 74-68 and then went on to beat Northwestern 91-73 to capture third place. Then, in 1978 after a good start on their season they came into the arena and lost to Dayton 97-80 and Penn State 64-57. Including regular season contests the series between the Flyers and Seminoles stands at 3-2 in favor of the Tribe. The Seminoles first round opponent UNCC have played the Flyers only once during the 1977-78 season (UD won 61-55). Hofstra and Dayton will meet for the first time ever this evening.

The winner of the UDIT will receive the Tom Blackburn Memorial Trophy, given in memory of the late Tom Blackburn, former UD head coach who started, nurtured and built the Flyers' great basketball tradition. In 17 seasons at Dayton, Blackburn won 352 games and lost only 141. His teams competed in 16 major tournaments — 10 NIT's, five E.C.A.C. Holiday festivals and one NCAA tourney. He died of cancer on March 6, 1964, but his legacy remains today.

The most valuable player in the UDIT will receive the Whitey Gillaugh Memorial trophy. It is in memory of the late H.W. Gillaugh, a Dayton banker who was a trustee on the lay board at UD, was active in school fund-raising and was a long-time sports fan.
