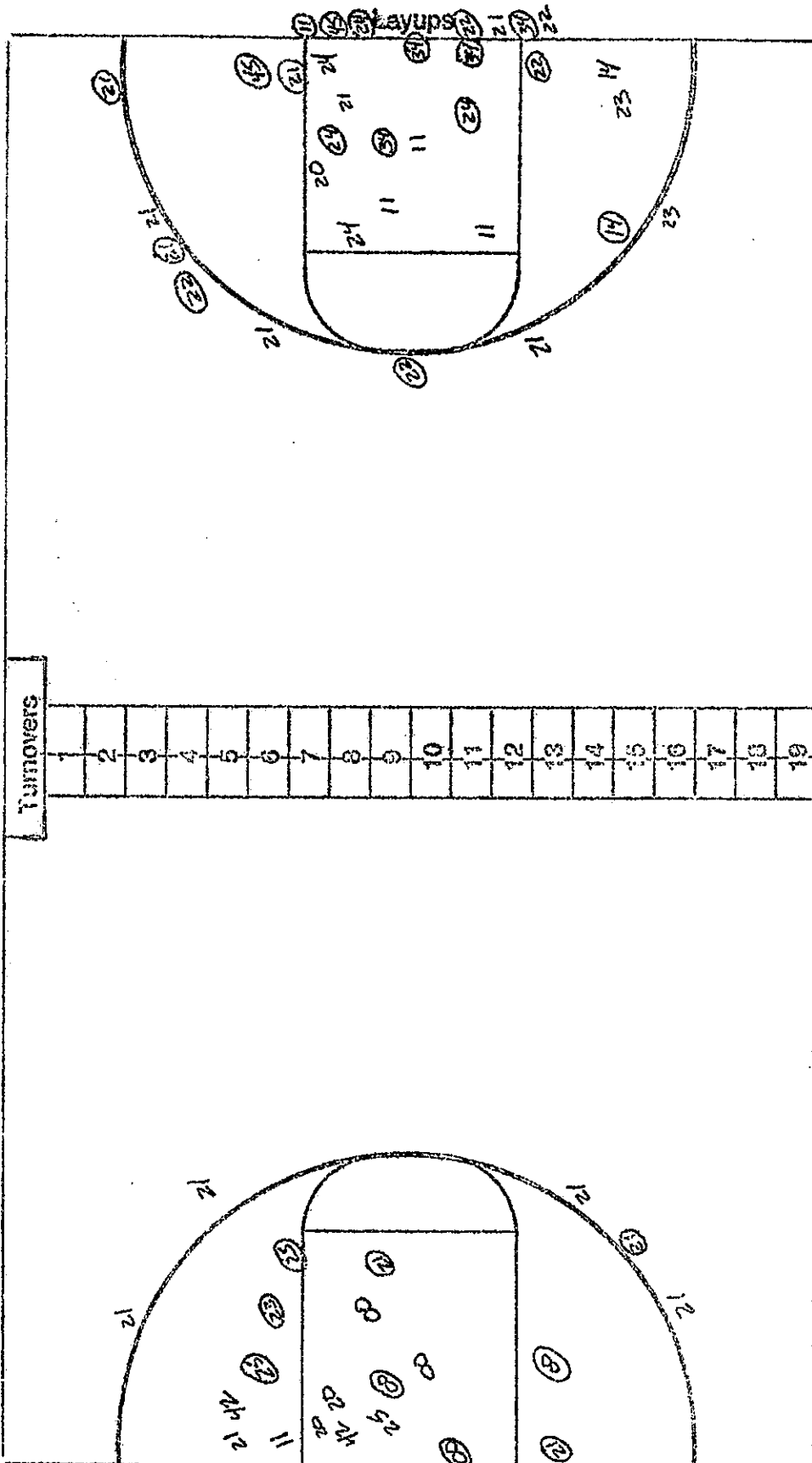

NCAA BASKETBALL SHOT CHART

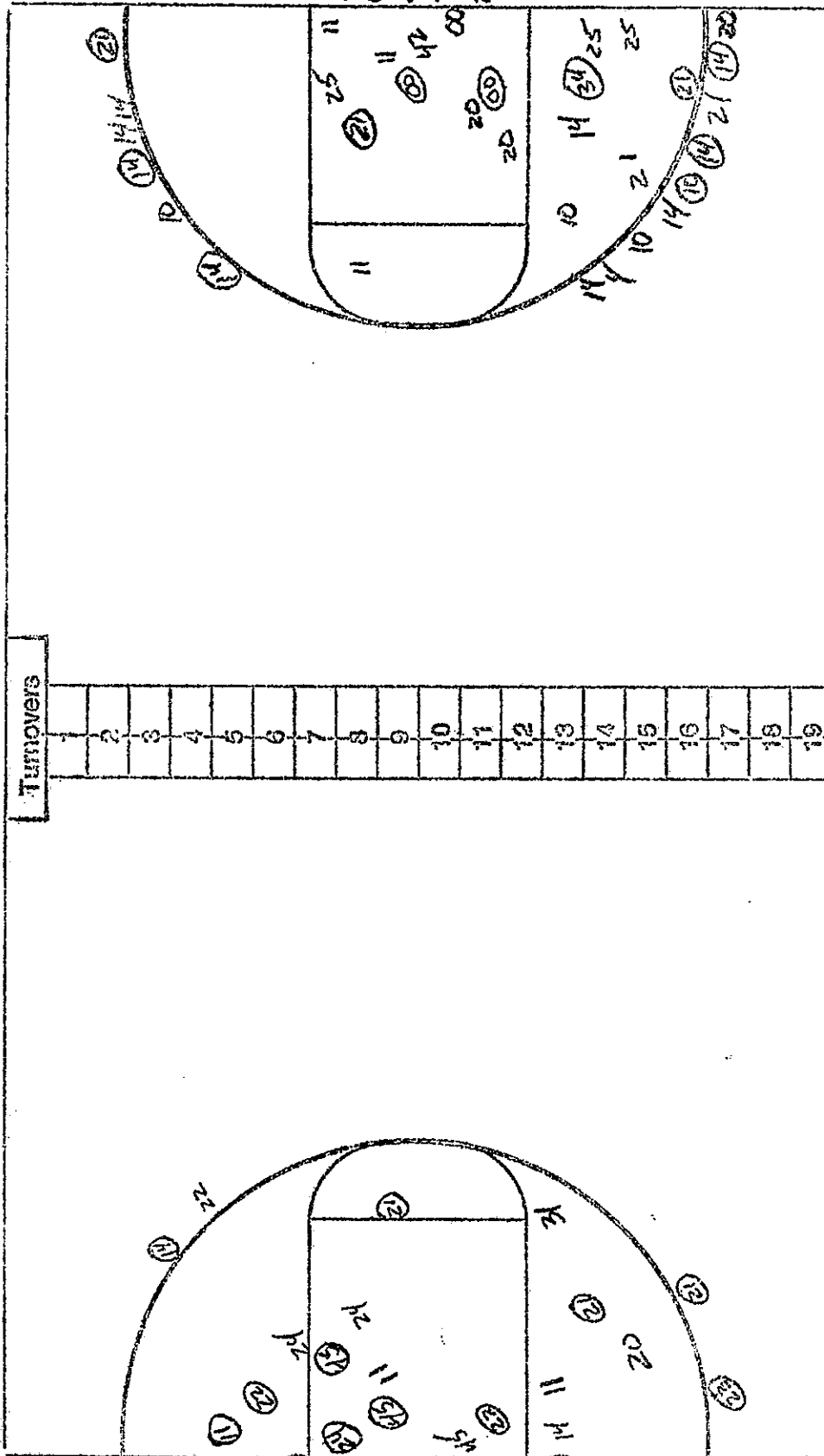

TONY YATES, CINCINNATI

"We're disappointed in the way our team played today. We thought they'd play a better basketball game. ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ We've always been able to play FSU pretty tough. We just got an old fashioned talkkiking.

Florida State was really sharp. Their half court defense was excellent and they executed their half court offense to perfection. They kind of pounded us real good.

(What did you tell your team when they are down by 30) We teach not to quit and to continued to fight and to execute and give it your best. You try to get to their pride in what they're going and what you're trying to accomplish. They (FSU) were a little more intense if I could put a figure on it."

(Who do you think the best team in the Metro is?) (Laughs) Usually it's the last team that plays us)

FLORIDA STATE'S PAT KENNEDY

"Obviously I think this was one of our premier games. This has to rank up there. We maintained our defense pressure throughout the game. Our half court trap was extremely aggressive.

I saw a lot of good offensive balance with Tharon coming on early in the game and shooting well and George McCroud maintaining consistency. We had a good ~~XXXXX~~ outside attack, good inside attack, good balance for 40 minutes.

All of these games are really important. I told them they got eight nights left that they ought to think are the most important thing in the world right now. I think that the most outstanding characteristic of this team is that they have ~~XXXX~~ showed a quick maturity...a comeback ability after last week.
