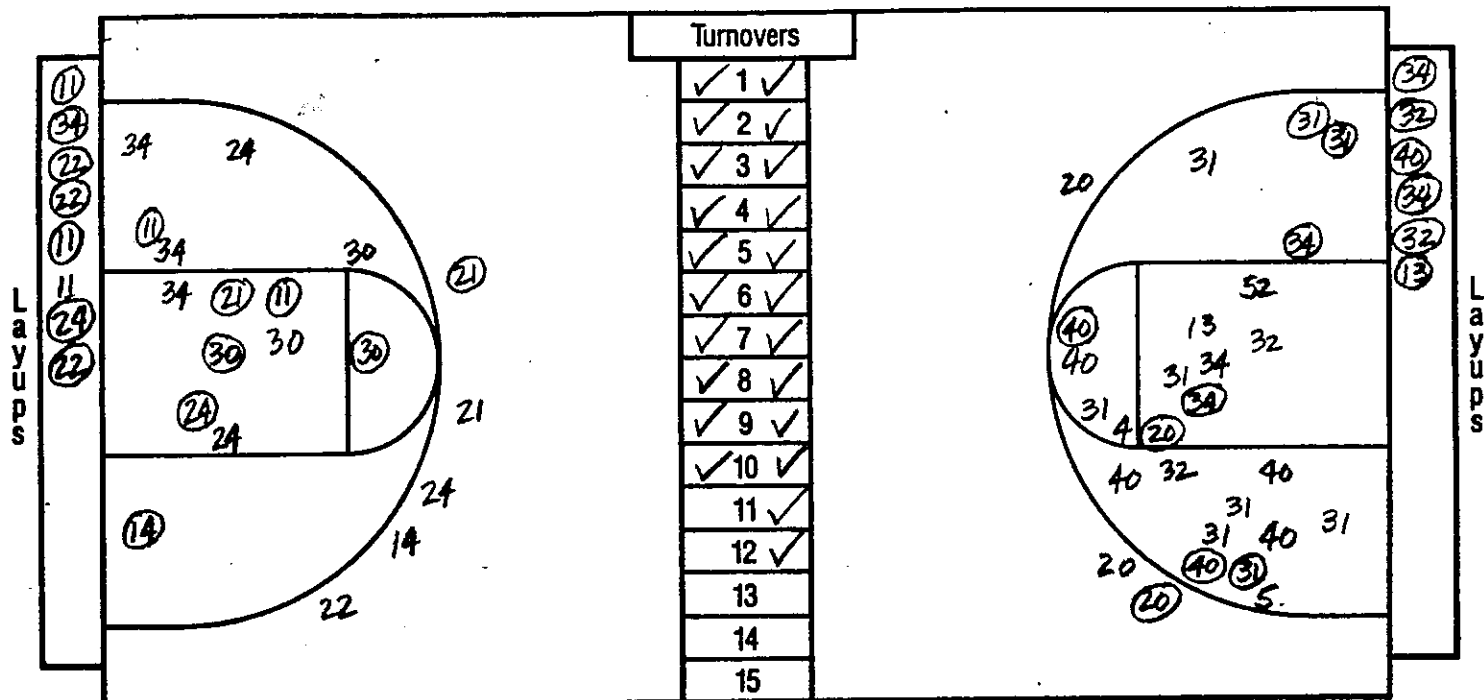
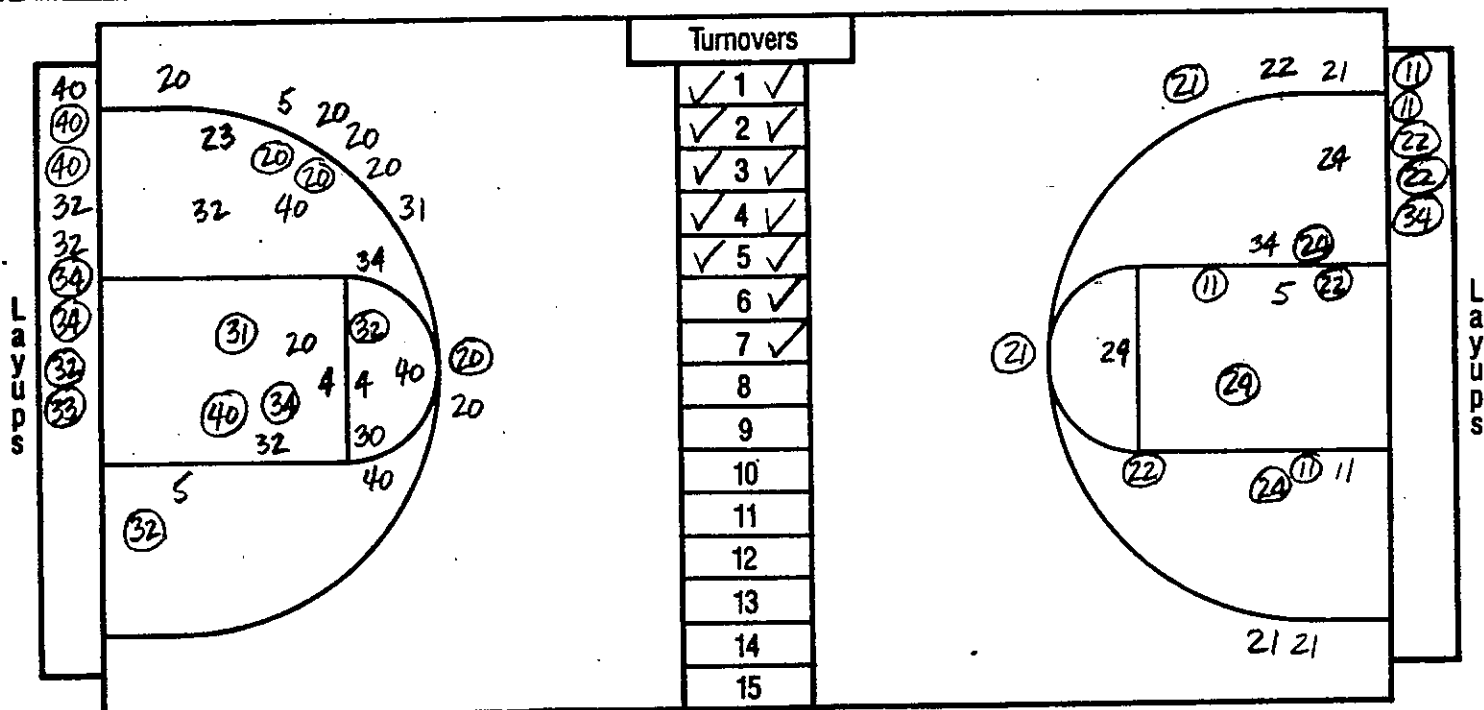

COACHES' QUOTES

COACH GEORGE FELTON

"I want to compliment Florida State. I thought they played a super game tonight. They showed that they are a legitimate top 20 team. I was disappointed in the fact that we let the tempo get away from us the past 2 games. To beat Florida State, we knew we had to be patient, but we played their tempo. I'm proud of the kids. They made a great run in the second half to cut it to 3 points.

"It's a tough way to end the season. I thought we accomplished a lot. Now we'll have to wait to see what happens. It was another year where we had a winning season and we progressed."

"Maybe we could have played a little more zone in the second half. Our man-to-man was working. Florida State executed well. They played a 3 guard attack very effectively. A lot of their points came from down in the paint and those are hard to stop."

(Regarding NCAA)

"I don't know. We're 19-10. We played a great schedule. We were competitive in the Metro. Everyone says we should have four teams (in the NCAA). I'm disappointed. We have improved our schedule over the years and showed we can be competitive. Even the people we lost to are in the NCAA. And we finished the season strong."

South Carolina - John Hudson

"Certainly today's loss was a very frustrating way to end the regular season. I felt that if we could go out there and execute our offense and defense, we would have a chance to win. I think, as coach said, that we were a little impatient at times and that hurt us."

South Carolina - Terry Dozier

"As coach said, we really don't know if we're in the NCAA Tournament. We'll just have to wait and see. I do want to take this opportunity to say for myself and my teammates that we all are very proud of our program this year and of Coach Felton and his staff. I've seen the change in Carolina basketball since he got here. He's turned it into a program to be reckoned with. He deserves to be in the NCAA Tournament. He's been through a lot since he came here. He inherited a probation team, and has rebuilt this program to one that has to be reckoned with throughout the conference. You have to give him and his staff a lot of credit for taking a group of young men from different backgrounds and turning them into a winning program. Despite what the score from today's game might indicate, we competed, and we did that throughout the season. It's something we all can take pride in."

COACHES' QUOTES

Coach Kennedy

"I think the best thing that came out of today is that we are playing the best basketball of the season. I thought the second game against LaSalle and the 2 games coming down the stretch we started to get it back. We had a great week of practice and we kind of had a healthy unit. We're pressing again which is what we wanted to do. Midway through the season, we started out with a lot of man-to-man pressure early in the year which helped us get our transitional game going. And then we had a slew of injuries and had to slow the game back down a bit. And then the kids have gotten back into their good defense. We are going to take the best opportunities out of defense. We were extremely unselfish. I thought it was the best balance attack we had all year. And it was the best defense we played all year. We got into a smaller line-up. We realized we were having slow starts. We lacked offensive penetration early in the game, and we were playing too much out on the perimeter. I think this is the best win of the season. It was a highly significant win for us beating a team such as South Carolina 3 times. And of course doing it in a semi final game, and there is some pressure to get into the championship game. The kids did an absolute super job. These guys have risen to the occasion, and they have accepted the challenge and they really played a great brand of basketball. We want to pick up the tempo. We need to start quicker. We're gonna start with a full court pressure. With George on the point and with Derrick and Tharon at the wing, Brad can play in that press, Lorenza can play in that press. Irv's coming off the bench now, and Irv gave us a good lift to tie us - - and we can use David in the press. It helps us put the whole aspect of what we're trying to do."

George McCloud

"With a three guard offense, it really creates a lot for Tharon and myself. When we're on the court, it's our whole team that presses. I'm at the head of the press. I can dish stuff out. I'm handling the ball. I can dish it up to Tharon and Derrick, and Derrick gives us the point guard penetration. He creates stuff for the inside player."

Derrick Mitchell

"Once the ball got to me, I became more of a starter, and created a lot of floor opportunities on my offense. My goal is basically to penetrate. My penetration not only creates more opportunities for the other guys, but I can dish out a lot."
