COACHES QUOTES: GEORGIA TECH 69, FLORIDA STATE 67

BOBBY CREMINS, GEORGIA TECH: "I thought played a great basketball game. They made it a great college game tonight. I thought Bobby Sura was gonna burn us. I kind of had little flashbacks of Charlie Ward. But Travis (Best) did a fantastic defensive job against a great player and Corey Louis got a great shot off and Drew (Barry) went in there and got the rebound. It was a great basketball game. Florida State is a very dangerous basketball team. It was a great win for us. We made a great comeback in the first half. Travis Best's shot right before the first half was sensational. And in the second half I thought we were going to take control, but with Bobby Sura and (James) Collins and Corey Louis. I recruited Corey. Corey was one of the top high school players in America last year. Collins, Collins is a high school all-American. Sura's three was absolutely unbelievable. It was one of the finest threes I've ever seen. But the little guy came back for us and James set a nice screen and he (Best) got fouled and made a clutch one and one. And I was really glad to see him make that. Those were two great free throws. James Forrest had a great tip in late. It was a wild and exciting game. We have a tendency to make things exciting. I'm just really glad we won. Like I said, I had flashbacks to Charlie Ward. I told Bobby after the game, 'I thought you were going to burn us again.' So, I'm glad this time the break went to Georgia Tech.

NOTES: For anyone's information, Travis Best has recently been timed going baseline to baseline with the basketball in 3.71 seconds...The 16 steals by Florida State ties the most ever against Georgia Tech by an opponent...North Carolina, Virginia, Augusta and Loyola Marymount each had previously record...Bob Sura's 9 steals ties the Florida State school record set by Charlie Ward and also ties the most by a Tech individual opponent...Derrick Phelps of North Carolina had 9 steals against the Jackets on Feb. 2, 1992...Tech's 19 turnovers ties its season's high recorded against East Carolina, Cincinnati and Maryland...Tech's win tonight is its first sweep of FSU since the Seminoles joined the league and is Tech's second straight win against FSU after six losses....With 25 points tonight, James Forrest now has 1,957 career points, just 43 shy of the 2,000-point mark...Travis Best, with 16 points tonight, now has 2,019 points for his career and moved into 25th place on the all-time ACC scoring list.

PAT KENNEDY, FLORIDA STATE: "It's been that kind of a season for us. I really feel for the kids. They've done such a great job. In fact, we're playing probably our best basketball right now. In two games, we've taken two good teams right to the wire. I don't think we've done it by just shooting well or by just throwing up a lot of threes. We're just simply playing the best basketball we've played all year, but we haven't gotten any W's to show for it. We took Carolina down to the last possession, and Bobby (Sura) had the ball and we did it again tonight. When you get a team like this on the road, or Carolina at home in that position and give your best player the ball, you've got to hope something happens. I was really hoping Bobby would get an opportunity to drive to the basket and get fouled, because we were in the one and one and we wanted to try to isolate him. When he came off the downscreen, there were still 16 or 17 seconds and he hesitated a little bit. I thought if we had attacked there at the end, we might have had a shot at it. Foul shots obviously hurt us. We put ourselves in position with a good job out of the pressure defense. The inspiring thing for us, is that I see Avery Curry out there going nose to nose with Travis Best and Corey Louis is going nose to nose with James Forrest and thank God those guys are leaving and our guys are just freshmen. That's about all I can say, because those two guys have had great careers. They are both extremely difficult to play. When James Forrest gets 100 percent healthy from whatever injuries he's had over the course of his career, I think he's still a tremendous NBA prospect.

ON THE LAST POSSESSION: "we wanted to get a good ball reversal to him (Sura). We were hopeful with ball reversal, to maybe get fouled with a pushing foul or a hand check, or get the ball in Bobby's hands and create whatever we could. We had guys spotted up and we had Corey down low and Sura slipped. A little different than the Carolina game, but the same situation."
