WALKS, BOOTS HURT FSU NINE

**Will Meet Mercer
Here Thursday**

The Mississippi college Choctaws gained an even break in their two-game series with Florida State University with a 13-3 decision over the Seminoles in a loosely played tilt in Centennial Field last night.

The Seminoles had copped the opener 6-0 Monday night behind "Howdy" Calhoun's brilliant three-hit mound effort.

Hampered by the wildness of starting pitcher Wade Howell, and shackled by their own fielding lapses the Seminoles were unable to check the Mississippians' attack.

Shaky Start

With Howell off to a shaky start in the opening frame the Choctaws got off to a four-run bulge concocted on a mixture of walks, errors and base hits.

After surviving the early outburst Howell settled down to hold the Choctaws away from the plate until the sixth while his mates chipped away at Choctaw chunker Beard with single tallies in the second and fourth frames.

Howell's control and support folded again in the sixth, however, and Mississippi chased a half dozen tallies across in their second big frame before the fire could be put out.

Mississippi continued to roll against Knight and picked up a pair of scores in the eighth and a single score in the ninth to complete the rout.

Walked Ten

Howell passed 10 men and fanned three during his stay on the mound, while Knight issued one free ticket, and whiffed five batsmen.

A total of 13 bobbles were committed by the two teams, with the Seminoles contributing eight of the fumbles.

Beard, who went all the way on the Choctaw mound, spaced out the Seminoles' five hits nicely in racking up his triumph.

Dago, Murphy, Sneads, contributed a triple to the muffled Seminole attack.

The Seminoles will meet Mercer's Bears here Thursday night in their next scheduled game.
