FSU BLASTS SAVANNAHANS

Win By 8 to 3
Behind Calhoun

The Florida State University Seminoles racked up their eighth victory of the season, and their fourth successive triumph last night when they hammered out an 8-3 win over the Savannah branch of the University of Georgia at Centennial field.

Backing Howard (Howdy) Calhoun's six-hit hurling with an 11-hit outburst of their own, the Seminoles picked up single tallies in the first, fourth, sixth and seventh and climaxed their scoring with a four-run outburst in the eighth to sew up the decision. Calhoun, big righthanded fast-baller from St Petersburg, blew 14 of the Savannah Bulldogs down on strikes in achieving his triumph.

After surviving a rough first inning that saw the Georgians score twice on a single basehit, Calhoun breezed along until the eighth when the UGS counted their third tally.

Bill Tanner, with a triple and a single, and Allen Parker, Wilson, and Padgett with two blows apiece, paced the Seminoles attack.
