TARS SWEEP FSU SERIES

**Down Seminoles
By 8-5, 8-2 Scores**

WINTER PARK, May 22, (AP)—The Rollins college baseball team made a clean sweep of their four-game series with Florida State University by taking an 8-2 decision here today.

The game ended the season for the Rollins state intercollegiate championship nine. They chalked up 21 victories in 25 games.

Gray Wins Ninth

John Gray, big freshman right-hander from West Palm Beach, hung up his ninth win against a single loss by turning in a two-hit performance against the FSU Seminoles and striking out 10 batters. He also collected a triple and a single in three trips to bat in two Rollins runs.

The Seminoles took a 2-1 lead in the second when they got two unearned runs off a base on balls, two errors and an infield hit.

The Tars got eight hits off John Witt, who went the distance for the Seminoles, with four of the hits, including Gray's triple, accounting for four runs in the fourth.
