Unleashing a 17-hit attack on four Choc hurlers that featured a trio of home runs by Ronald Melton, Sam Cox and "Greasy" Gresham, FSU quickly piled up an early lead in the first four innings.

Trailing 13-5 at the end of the fourth, the Chocs rallied to pull up to a 14-13 deficit going into the ninth, but FSU exploded with a four-run burst to put the decision out of reach of the rallying Chocs.
