

Florida State University's baseball team was scheduled to close its two-game series with Mississippi College this afternoon on the West campus diamond at 3.

Either right handers John Witt, West Palm Beach, or Royce Burt, Tallahassee, was slated to pitch for the Seminoles in an attempt to make it two straight over the Choctaws here.

Yesterday a crowd of about 300 people watched the Seminoles come from behind to edge Mississippi, 5 to 4, after losing a one run lead in the first inning.

### Hits Third Homer

Centerfielder Lamar Brown, whose heavy clouting has featured FSU's play all season, led the Seminole attack. Brown scored the winning run in the eighth inning after beating out an infield hit and stealing third. He came home on a long fly by Roger Drohan.

The Indian, battling accounts for two more runs in the sixth when he walloped a towering homer to right with Ronald Melton on base. It was Brown's third round tripper of the year.

Lefty Sam Cox, Quincy, registered his third straight win with-

out a setback, although he was touched for ten hits by Choctaw batters. FSU collected eight.
