Seminoles Sweep Choc Series 11-6

The Florida State University Seminoles built up a big early lead then coasted home to an 11-6 triumph over the Mississippi College Choctaws at the West campus athletic

field yesterday afternoon.

The victory gave the Seminoles a clean sweep of their two-game series with the Chocs, and marked their sixth win in 10 starts this season.

Second baseman Moe Allen and pitcher John Drohan paced Coach Charlie Armstrong's nine to its third win of the year over the Chocs.

Allen slammed three hits, a home run, double and single to lead the attack.

Drohan pitched 10-hit bath and kept the Chocs well in hand until his mates had built up an 11-1 margin through the first six frames.

Drohan had several wobbly spots over the route, but he mixed in 12 strikeouts to work his way out of most of his early inning trouble.

Allen's double in the first frame started the Seminoles on their way to their first run. In the second the second sacker blasted a tremendous rome run to right field to give FSU a 3-1 lead that they never lost.

Allen's third hit, a single, was part of the Indians big five-run fifth which clinched the tilt.

In the big inning singles by Allen, Cox and Boyd, mixed with three bases on balls and a pair of Choc errors sent both Ross and Clemons from the mound.
