

Mocs Win 4-2

Coach Dick Morland's Mocs captured the opener of the two-game series Friday afternoon 4-2 when eight FSU errors kept the Indians in hot water.

After getting off to a 2-0 lead in the second frame, Southern picked up single runs in the sixth and ninth to offset FSU two tallies in the third and ninth.
