

The Bradley University Braves of Peoria Ill. gained an even split in their two-game series with the Florida State University Seminoles here by trouncing the Indians 10-1 at the West campus athletic field yesterday. Florida State won the opener Monday, 3-2.

The game started out like it was going to be another close one with neither team scoring in the first four innings. The Braves found the range in the fifth, however, and from there on it was "no contest."

Extra Base Blows

Bradley got two runs in the fifth, three in the sixth, one in the seventh and then four more in the ninth. The Braves were pounding extra base knocks to all parts of the field, and Florida State helped matters along for the visitors with five errors, three of which came in the ninth stanza.

Bradley centerfielder Bill Tuttle continued to pace his team in hitting with a home run and a double in five trips to the plate. Jack Hills got three hits in four tries, including a triple, for Bradley, while Ronald Melton led the Florida State attack for the second straight day with two singles.

Lockard Wild

Witt relieved Ed Lockard for the Seminoles in the first inning when the big freshman couldn't find the plate and had loaded the bases with nobody out. Witt got dangerous Bill Tuttle on strikes and forced Gene Melchiorre, Bradley's basketball star, to hit into a double play. This fine relief job went for naught, however, as the Braves began teeing off in the later innings.

Florida State's lone marker came last of the sixth inning when Ronald Nettles led off with a walk and scored on Witt's triple over the Bradley leftfielder's head. Only one other Seminole reached second base during the entire game.
