

# Florida State, Stetson Play 6-6 Deadlock

DELAND, April 15 — Big Walt Jasinski who blanked Florida State University Friday on five hits, came back to haunt the Seminoles—again—today when he slammed a three-run pinch double to lead Stetson to a 6-6 tie in an abbreviated college baseball game.

The tilt was called at the end of the sixth to clear the field for a Florida State league night game.

Jasinski batted for Bob Hall in the fifth with the bases loaded and promptly doubled to pull the Hatters up to a 6-5 deficit. Jasinski then scored the tying run on Bill Johnson's two-play wallop.

McNulty and Wimer held FSU to two hits, but four errors and a flock of passes set up State's six tallies.

Today's deadlock will be played off on May 20 when the hatters invade Tallahassee in a return series.
