

The Florida State University Seminoles defeated the University of Georgia Bulldogs 9 to 4 in a baseball game at the West Campus athletic field here yesterday afternoon.

The Seminoles, who now sport a 2-0 record with both victories coming over Southeastern Conference foes, left this morning for Miami where they are scheduled

terday's win over Georgia. Lockard tossed seven-hit ball against the Bulldogs, and helped his own cause by registering two singles and scoring a run.

Bailey, Pompella and Melton also each cracked out a pair of safeties against Georgia. Bailey's blows were a double and a triple, while Melton had a double.

Bailey's game opening double, singles by Glen Gresham and Bob Trowbridge, an infield out and a wild pitch got the Seminoles off to a good start with three runs in the first inning. Bailey tripled down the right field foul line with two down in the second frame and scored on another wild pitch to make it 4-0 in favor of the Seminoles.

LOSES CONTROL

Florida State added two more runs in the third inning on a single by Pompella, Melton's double, Ken Smith's long fly out to center field and a Georgia error.

Lockard lost his control momentarily top of the sixth inning and Georgia took immediate advantage to chalk up three markers and get back into the ball game. The Bulldogs' hopes were short-lived, however, as Florida State tacked on one run in the seventh and two in the eighth to put the game on ice.
