Ken Smith's triple and Ed Lockard's fly evened the count again the fourth.

After Harry Bringer's single, an error and a fly by Ken Smith put the invaders in front in the sixth, the roof fell in and in the last three rounds nine Seminoles tallied as Eddie Dunn shoved in nine reserves trying to halt the attack.
