

# FSU CLUBS MOCS, 15-6

## State Foes Play Again Today

**LAKELAND** — Florida State

University's Seminoles slammed eight runs across in a wild third inning here last night and went on to pound out a 15-6 decision over Florida Southern in the opener of a two-game series.

The two teams were slated to meet again today, with basketball star Bob Hartman likely to get the starting nod from Seminole Coach Charlie Armstrong.

The Indians raked the offerings of three Moc pitchers for 11 hits in last night's abbreviated seven-inning fracas and took advantage of 10 free passes and three Southern errors in rolling to their fourth win of the season against one loss.

### SESSIONS GOES ROUTE

Backed by the scoring assault, lanky Ed Sessions had little trouble coasting to the triumph though he was tagged for seven hits and issued 10 bases on balls.

Sessions collected three of the Seminoles 11 hits himself, but first sacker Ken Smith swung the most potent bat for the Indians, driving home four runs and scoring three times. One of Smith's blows was a double. Lee Bailey had a pair of two-ply wallops for FSU.
