

FSU SWEEPS MOC SERIES

Bob Hartman Hurls 13-3 Triumph

LAKE LAND—Florida State University staged another big inning here yesterday to sweep its series from Florida Southern with a 13-3 triumph.

Coach Charlie Armstrong's Seminoles, who had scored eight runs in the third inning Monday night in fashioning a 15-6 victory, threw another eight run frame at the Mocs yesterday—this time in the second inning, and coasted on in to their fifth triumph of the season against only one defeat.

Basketball star Bob Hartman went the route for FSU. He yielded only 7 blows and was stingy in the pinches limiting Southern to single runs in the third, sixth and eighth inning.

While Hartman was holding the Mocs at bay his mates pummeled the offerings of four enemy hurlers for 13 hits, two of which were doubles by Glen Gresham and Augie Pompella. Centerfielder Les Mullens banged out three safeties, to rank number one on the hit parade.
