Lanky Ed Sessions, former Leon high of Tallahassee star, pitched the first six innings for the Seminoles and was credited with the victory. Leron Rice, a newcomer on the squad this season, finished up on the mound. Both hurlers were effective at the plate, Sessions getting four singles in five appearances and Rice his four-bagger.

Coach Charlie Armstrong indicated that he would send curve-baller Bob Hartman to the hill in this afternoon's game with the Choctaws. It was scheduled to begin at 3 o'clock.
