

Florida State University's hopes for the mythical state baseball crown were crushed yesterday afternoon as Walt Jasinski pitched the Stetson University baseball team to a 7-5 victory over the Seminoles.

Five runs in the top of the seventh inning gave the Hatters the game. Bunching five of their 11 hits and three Seminole errors in that inning the Stetson team took the game and sent starter Ed Sessions to the showers. Ed Lockard, Friday's winning pitcher for the Seminoles, took over pitching chores, but the damage was done.

A ninth inning rally by the FSU team felt two runs short of the four runs needed to tie the game up. In that inning, Lee Bailey unloaded a booming home run into deep left-center field with the bases empty.

The Hatters were paced at the plate by Merrill Smith, their second baseman, who had three bingles in five appearances at the plate. Shortstop Augie Pompelia was the only Seminole to pick up more than one blow. Pompelia had two singles in four times at the plate and drove in two of the baseball seasons for both Florida State and Stetson.
