Fierida State moved to its fourth win of the year here yesterday behind the smooth six-hit pitching of Freshman "Lefty" Chuck Sanders, defeating Amherst (Mass.) Gellege 4-2.

Sanders struck out one and allowed only three walks to hold a fine Amherst team in check. Four of the six Amherst hits were of the scratchy variety.

MILLS STARTS IT

Florida State got its first score in the initial inning when Cooter Mills led off with a single to right field, moved to second when Ken Smith was hit by a pitched ball to third as Bob Trowbridge walked, and scored on Bonald Melton's infield out.

Amherst tied the score in the top of the second inning, Bucky Harris went all the way to second on Melton's error and scored as Bill Greer bounced a single off Banders' foot into right field.

The Seminoles iced the game in the fourth inning off Bill Wilson, the first of four Amherst pitchers and the loser, with three markers. With two outs, Ralph Blinn singled down the right field foul line and went to third on Ham Wernke's single to penter. Blinn soored and Wernke moved to second when Wilson threw wide to first on Rudy Susege's easy roller to the mound. Sanders walked to load the bases, then Mills and Smith both got free tickets to first to force in two more runs. Les Mullen struck out is end the Seminole vally.

Shoddy support kept Sanders in trouble in the late innings, but the tall southpaw had it when it counted. Two Florida State errors contributed to the final Amherst run which was scored in the sev-
