COP OPENER

With John "The Whip" Witt turning in FSU's top mound performance of the season, the Seminoles copped the series opener from Loyola's highly-rated Wolfpack, 1-0 in a Friday afternoon pitching duel.

Witt, veteran righthander returning to the slab after a year's layoff, parceled out just five blows to the New Orleans Wolfpack, walked only two men and struck out five.

Senior Captain Bob Trowbridge and freshman Ham Wernke furnished Witt with the little offensive help he needed to shade righthander Tony Majoria in an oldfashioned mound battle.

Trowbridge was hit by a pitched ball in the sixth frame, worked around to third base, and cantered across the plate on Wernke's long fly to left field.

Majoria allowed only four blows, but walked six.

Two double plays, one of which he started himself, helped Majoria escape from a couple of other scoring threats

Marion Dauphin's double for the Wolfpack was the only extra base blow of the game.
